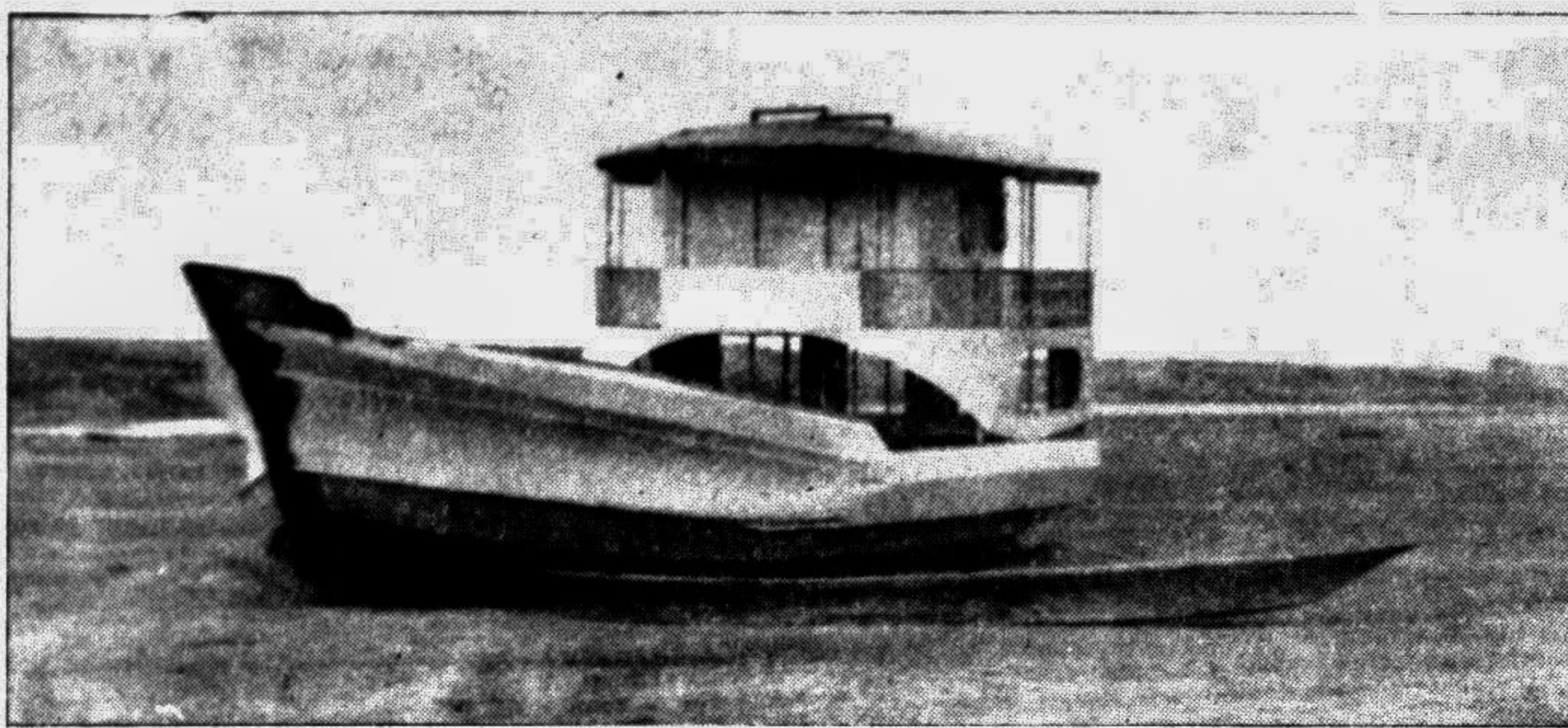


### 18,400 hectares of land brought under mustard cultivation

**BRAHMANBARIA, Dec 3:** A total of 18,400 hectares of land have been brought under mustard cultivation in seven thanas of the district during current rabi season, reports UNB.

According to Agriculture Extension Department (AED) sources, of the total, 5,000 hectares in sadar, 3,000 hectares in Sarail, 1,400 hectares in Kasba, 4,200 hectares in Babinagar, 600 hectares in Akhaura, 2,000 hectares in Bancharampur and 2,200 hectares in Nasir-nagar thanas were brought under the programme.

The production target has been fixed at 16,560 metric tons, the sources said adding that the target might not be achieved due to untimely rainfall in the current month of Agrabayan (November-December). Price hike of fertiliser is also hampering the mustard cultivation in the district, they said.

## Shoals in Northern rivers hinder navigation

**SIRAJGANJ, Dec 3:** A large number of shoals (charlands) have emerged in 135-mile long river route from Doik-hawa in Kurigram district to Doulatdia in Manikganj district in the basins of Teesta, Brahmaputra, Dhaleswari, Jamuna and Padma rivers hindering smooth navigation in the areas.

It was learnt that after the devastating floods of this year, water level of the major rivers has started falling and about 5000 small and big chars have emerged in the river beds.

Every year during the dry season, the chars emerge in the river routes but the number has increased this year. Due to emergence of chars navigational traffic

is hampered much. Massive dredging is going on in the eastern part of Jamuna Bridge site at Kalihati thana in Tangail district and in Aricha-Doulatdia route to keep navigability. According to the sources of Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority (BIWTA) the channels of rivers Teesta, Brahmaputra, Dhaleswari, Jamuna and Padma are always changeable and skilled pilots even fail to guide the ships and vessels towards the destination. The channels once prepared can not be kept navigable sometimes, for seven days. The channels are closed due to siltation following carrying of soil by the rivers from the upstream. The Railway ferry service in Sirajganj-Jagan-

nathganj route remains suspended for about two years and the same in Teestamukh-Bahadurabad route is disturbed. Motor launch service in Sirajganj-Bhuapur ghat route is also disrupted. The launches anchor about five kilometers to the east from Bhuapur and the passengers are to cross this part of Dhaleswari river by the engine boats incurring much expenses and wastage of time. Motor launch service in Enayetpur-Aricha, Enayetpur-Shohagpur-Sirajganj, Shohagpur-Bhuapur and Sirajganj-Kazipur river routes have been closed down long ago which could not be resumed after several attempts. Ferry service in Nagarbari-Aricha-Doulatdia routes are

also disturbed as it takes much time to cross the rivers.

Due to emergence of shoals, the channel markers often misguide the vessels and the ships more than seven feet drafts are sometimes stranded in the mid-river causing sufferings to the passengers and damage of merchandised goods as well.

Dredgings are effective always in the said rivers. Every year, after erosion the trend of flow is changed and it is found that channels of pre-flood period have turned to chars in the post-flood time. The BIWTA also have to set the channel markers time to time causing wastage of time and money.

### Lack of pure drinking water in Kushtia town

**KUSHTIA, Dec 3:** Kushtia Pourashava authority has failed to supply pure drinking water to its town dwellers causing immense difficulties.

It was reported that 30 lakh gallons of water are needed every day for one lakh 50 thousand town dwellers while poura authority could supply only 9 lakh gallons from 12 deep tubewells installed for the purpose.

Reasons behind the shortage of water has been attributed to the non-functioning of six deep tubewells and the rest six also could not supply water according to their capacity.

There are 41 kilometre water pipe line and number of consumers are 2426.

Besides there are 937 hand tubewells which also are not working well due to fall of ground water level. Town dwellers urged the authorities concerned to provide them with adequate drinking water facilities.

### Construction work of digital telephone exchange going on in Barisal

**BARISAL, Dec 3:** Construction work of a five thousand line digital telephone exchange is going on in full swing at the Divisional Telephone Exchange Complex, reports BSS.

According to an official source, the work on this project is expected to be completed by December.

Digital telephone components from Italy are being fitted by the Italian engineers in collaboration with Bangladeshi experts.

The exchange is expected to be inaugurated this year.

## Plan undertaken to distribute post flood agri-loans

**JAMALPUR, Dec 3:** Different government banks and sangstha have taken up separate programmes to disburse agricultural loans among the flood-hit farmers and the destitute men and women of the rural areas for self-employment projects in the all seven thanas of the district during the current year.

The government recently decided to provide agricultural loans to flood-affected farmers to help them recoup their losses by the current year's devastating flood.

According to official sources, the authorities will distribute Taka 38,47,00,000 as short term loan and Taka 1,10,00,000 as medium term.

The amount will be distributed for purchasing seeds, cattle, irrigation equipments and crop cultivation. It was also learnt.

Bangladesh Krishi Bank (BKB) and Sonali Bank have already started distribution of the loans and it might be completed by June 30 next, according to Agrani Bank, AGM office sources.

The Bangladesh Rural Development Board (BRDB) has sanctioned a sum of Taka 1 crore 20 lakh to flood-hit farmers for cultivation of different kinds of crop during the current year.

It was known that the board has as many as 3242 samities under BRDB.

Out of the total amount Taka 20 lakh was sanctioned for transplanted aman crop for the members of these samities.

BRDB has taken up a programme to disburse Taka 9.5 crore loan among the

destitute men and women of the flood-hit rural areas for self-employment projects in the all seven thanas of the district during the current year.

The board, under its rural development project 'RD-12' will disburse the money. According to the sources, Taka 1.5 crore will be disbursed in Jamalpur sadar, Taka 1 crore in Melandah, Taka 97 lakh in Sarishabari, Taka 1 crore 50 lakh in Dewanganj, Taka 1 crore 50 lakh in Madarganj, Taka 1 crore 53 lakh in Islampur and rest is Bakhshiganj thanas.

The board has already disbursed 2.5 crore among some 7,000 members of the RD-12 project of the district in the first phase.

The self-employment project incorporates crop production, fish and livestock cultivation, small business, etc.

### Various problems hamper education in Satkhira

SATKHIRA, Dec 3: Educational activities in different private high schools in seven thanas of the district are being hampered due to various problems, including fund crisis, reports UNB.

Official source said academic life of the students of about 200 private high schools in the district had been threatened due to lack of educational appliances, shortage of furniture and accommodation.

Most of the schools set up by the local people with their own initiatives have not yet been affiliated by the government. The schools may face closure if the organisers failed to arrange adequate funds," said a school teacher.

According to local guardians, a number of school buildings damaged during the natural calamities have not yet been repaired.

They urged the government to take immediate steps to affiliate the non-registered schools and provide necessary funds.

## Govt primary schools in 5,280 villages absent

**JESSORE, Dec 3:** Half of total villages in ten districts of Khulna Division remains outside the coverage of on-going compulsory Primary Education Programme. Absence of government primary schools has been the cause of this situation, sources said.

According to a reliable source, there is no government primary school in 5,280 villages while the total number of villagers are 9,040.

According to statistical reports, in Jessore district there are only 622 government primary schools in a total of 1,460 villages.

In Jhenidah, number of government primary schools are 287 while the number of villages are 1,106.

In Mugura, number of government primary schools are 267 against 723 villages.

In Narail, number of government primary schools are 287. Number of villages are 676.

In Khulna, there are 626 government primary schools while number of villages are 991.

In Satkhira there are 629 schools while the number of villages are 1,360.

In Bagerhat, total number of government primary schools are 602 and number of villages are 934.

In Kushtia, the number of government primary schools are 430 while the total number of villages are 1023.

In Chuadanga, there are 247 government primary schools while the total number of villages are 520.

In Meherpur, number of government primary schools are 161 while total number of villages are 247.

Mushroom growth of non-government primary schools and kindergartens in and around urban areas, has been reported recently. But this trend has still slim chances to touch rural areas.

Response of people to

non-formal Primary Education Programme in rural areas are quite unsatisfactory, not to speak of non-government primary schools. Abject poverty and subjective backwardness still remain the prime cause.

Another source said that very few primary schools at non-government level in rural areas are coming into being due to dearth of patronisation and initiative in right earnest. The handful of such schools that have been registered at villages present deplorable picture.

Some of these schools have reportedly been regis-

tered out of political influence without fulfilling the requisite conditions.

Reports received from different sources reveal that the arrival and departure of teachers are most irregular. Number of students attending is negligible.

Huge number of children are being deprived of primary education following lack of such schools in every village. In fact, cumulative effects of all these have adversely affected the aims and objectives of the announced compulsory Primary Education Programme.

### 25 die of hydrophobia during last 10 months

**COX'S BAZAR, Dec 3:** At least 25 people died of hydrophobia in the last ten months in seven thanas under Cox's Bazar district due to want of anti-rabies vaccine (ARV).

Hospital sources and local people said the number of patients bitterly the rabid dogs have now exceeded 200.

It was learnt that on an average 20 people are bitten by dogs in the district every week. Of them, 50 goes to the village quacks for treatment and the rest comes to the hospital and health complexes to collect vaccines.

Health officials of the pourashava said a large number of people from Mohekhali, Kutubdia, Cokoria, Ramu, Ukha and Teknaf thanas also comes to the district headquarters to collect the vaccine.

But due to the scarcity of the vaccine for the last four months the death toll is on rise. Pourashava sources said, at least 25 courses of vaccine were needed in the town monthly but they can provide only five to seven courses.

The sources said Public Health Institute, the only manufacturing agency of the vaccine is on the verge of closure for want of raw materials and administrative irregularities. To meet the growing demand the vaccine had been imported from neighbouring India for the time being which was also stopped for unknown reason. As a result the crisis of ARV vaccine persists all over the country.

The institute stopped supply of the vaccines to other districts. Only a man with valid prescription can get the vaccine from the institute directly, it was learnt.

Acute shortage of anti-rabies vaccine is also prevailing in seven thana headquarters causing suffering to a large number of patients. The rural people who were attacked by the rabid dogs during the last four months could not receive anti-rabies vaccine due to its scarcity in the hospitals and health complexes.

Cox's Bazar pourashava authorities said, after repeated appeal to higher authorities no step has yet been taken to supply the same.

Local people said that the vaccine is rarely available in the market and the price is beyond the purchasing capacity of the common people.

### Smuggled goods worth Tk 29.24cr seized, 472 held

**KHULNA, Dec 3:** Smuggled goods worth over Tk 29.24 crore were seized by Bangladesh Rifles from different border areas under Khulna Sector during the first 11 months of this year, reports UNB.

Of the total, goods worth Tk 26.24 crore were seized while coming into the country and the goods worth Tk 3 crore were seized while being smuggled to India, official sources said.
