Japan gives Nepal \$ 6m

KATHMANDU Dec Japan has given Nepal six million dollars as part of the Japanese debt relief mea sures (second portion) 1995 a Japanese embassy press release said yesterday, reports AFP.

Sigenobu Yoshida. Japanese Ambassador to Nepal, and Ram Binod Bhattara, acting Secretary at Nepal's Finance Ministry. signed the agreement at the finance ministry Monday, the statement said.

Yoshida said he believes Japan will continue to give aid to Nepal, to support the kingdom's development ef-

Japan gave Nepal about six million dollars for debt relief measures (first portion) on June 20.

The grant will be used to buy fertilisers and equipment for construction, communication, transportation, fire fighting, petroleum products. medicines, and irrigation barrages gates.

EC extends \$ 40m as grant to South Africa

BRUSSELS, Dec 5: The European Commission yesterday extended grants totaling 40 million dollars to South Africa to finance four development projects, reports AFP.

It said 14.5 million dollars would be earmarked for a programme to assist university libraries and provide teaching material to underprivileged institutions.

A second grant of 4.5 mil lion dollars was to assist students seeking to pursue scientific studies.

The commission also extended a 19.5 million dollar facility to South African Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) through the transitional National Development Trust, and agency created through the merger of the Kagiso Trust and the Independent Development Trust.

ADB okays \$ 35 m loan to Mongolia

MANILA. Dec 5: The Asian Development Bank (ADB) today approved a 35-million-dollar loan and a 1.38-million-dollar technical assistance grant to Mongolia to help its agricultural sector, the bank said, reports Reuter.

The Manila-based regional lending institution said the interest-free loan, payable in 40 years, aims to assist Mongolia's agriculture sector shift to market-based competition by removing price controls and privatising crop farms.

It said the grant would be used to strengthen institutions in the sector and improve land use policies.

WB Vice President says

Free trade move to benefit economies of South Asia

ISLAMABAD, Dec 5: Moves to liberalise trade in South Asia offer the prospect of significant gains for all economies in the region, said World Bank Vice President Shahid Javed Burki yesterday, reports Xinhua.

Speaking at a seminar on regional economic cooperation here. Burki said a trend toward unilateral trade liberalisation has been underway in South Asia for several years, consisting of reductions in the maximum tariff and of certain quantitative restrictions.

But he pointed out, there remains much important and useful ground still to be covered in respect of conventional, unilateral, mostfavoured nation liberalisation.

The experience of Latin America indicates that collateral measures, such as simplification of procedures, improvement of border infrastructure and clarity in dispute resolution can be important in promoting inter-regional trade. Burki said.

He suggested that Pakistan should aim to have such measures included on the South Asia Preferential Trade Agreement (SAPTA) agenda.

Burki identified three fundamental economic interests in the trade area for Pak-

istan which are to enhance the efficiency, competitiveness and flexibility of its own economy to maintain and enhance access to India, the largest economy in the re-

He noted that SAPTA provides distinct benefits for Pakistan, adding that with historically lower tariff barriers than India, particularly on consumer items, Pakistani producers should the competitive in niches in the Indian market.


