Wishes to Indigenize Successful Nation-wide Poverty Alleviation Program

Expressions of interest are invited from both Bangladesh government and nongovernment organizations, or a consortium thereof, to undertake on transfer from CARE-Bangladesh, the program ownership, management, and operation of the Income Diversification Component (IDC) of the Rural Maintenance Program (RMP).

Initiated in 1983 by CARE, the RMP now employs over 36,000 destitute women per year to maintain rural earthen roads in 3,600 Unions throughout Bangladesh. The road maintenance component of the RMP is now being transferred to the Local Government Engineering Department of the Ministry of Local Government. The Ministry now seeks a partner with the capacity to assume responsibility for the IDC as well as to contribute to overall RMP coordination.

The Income Diversification Component provides livelihood management skills training to approximately 10,000 women who graduate from road maintenance work each year. The IDC training module requires qualified and dedicated staff to persist in equipping these women with necessary tools for realizing economic security such as: basic financial and business management, micro investment, survival planning; as well as presenting options for income diversification.

Qualifications: Demonstrated commitment of working with destitute women; recognized achievement in participatory training; ability to manage, implement and staff a nation-wide training program; previous experience in working with government and NGOs; reputed monitoring and evaluation systems; and sound management and financial solvency.

Requirements: Interested parties must submit a statement of organizational capabilities addressing the above criteria (max. 4 pages); past 3-year audit reports; pertinent program evaluations; personnel manual; staffing profile; annual workplan; and current 3-5 year strategic plan, to The PRIP Trust by 31 December 1995.

Survey on JS polls 67pc support shifting of polls schedule

Sixty-seven per cent lawyers, surveyed in an opinion poll suggest that the time schedule of the next general elections be shifted to ensure participation of all major political parties.

The survey, conducted among 500 law years, further revealed that 24 per cent think the election should be held before Ramadan as scheduled.

Only 26 per cent lawyers expressed opinion in favour of holding polls under the supervision of a caretaker government after resignation of the Prime Minister, the survey, conducted by the National Democratic Foundation (NDF), revealed.

Sixty-seven per cent of the lawyers held the view that a government could be formed with equal number of opposition and ruling party members under the leadership of the President.

Thirty-four per cent said, if the sixth general elections were held without participation of major political parties, the next parliament would not be able to complete its tenure decrease.
