Housewife commits suicide in Habiganj

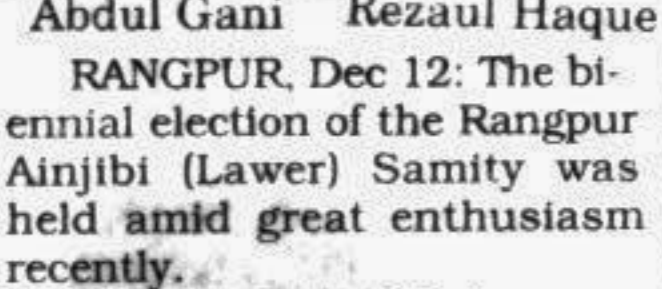

People of C'Nawabganj demand checking of Padma erosion

CHAPAINAWABGONJ, Dec 12: People of the 'char' areas of Chapainawabganj brought out a large procession demanding checking of erosion of the 'char' areas by the river Padma. The erosion has been going on for about 25 years. Till now 31 villages have been devoured.

The erosion by Padma started from 1971. But in the last 3 years erosion took a serious turn affecting large number of schools, madrasahs, mosques and about 10 thousand acres of cultivable land. A century-old school named Narayanpur high school has also gone under water. Birshrestha Shaheed captain Mohiuddin Jahangir College is also under the threat of erosion. The erosion affected areas are — Narayanpur, Johorpur, Tiklichar, Bakhar Ali, Jaonia, Sardarpara, Murgipara of Nawabganj Sadar thana and Paka, Jokepara, Dillarpara, Durlapur of Shibgonj thanas.

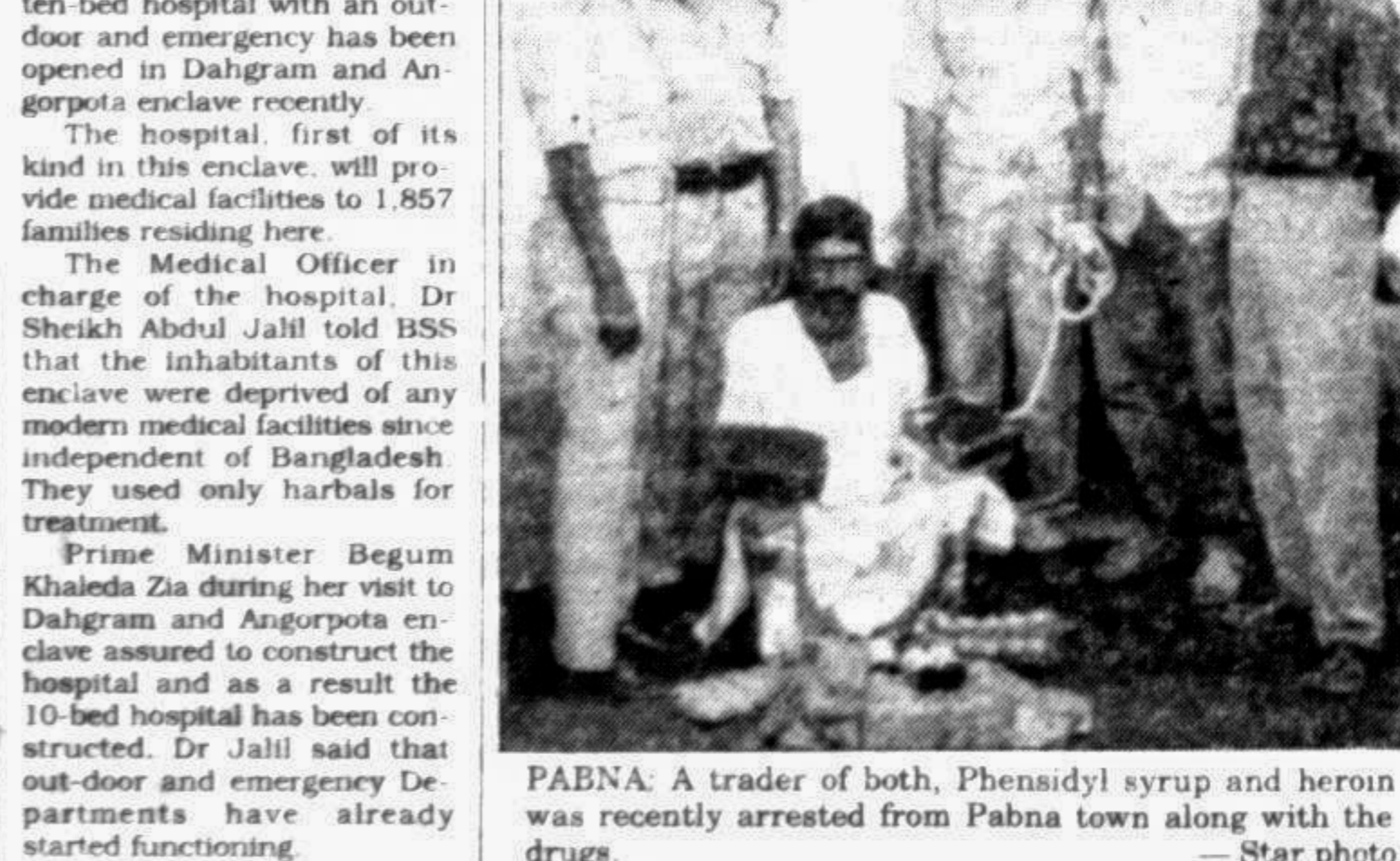
Of the total, some 24 schemes were implemented under general sector and the rest 45 were in the development sector, official sources said.
