mishaps during last 10 days

SUNAMGANJ, Dec 12: The number of road mishaps on Sylhet-Sunamganj road is on rise due to reckless driving of vehicles, local people said, reports UNB.

According to police, within the last 10 days, at least four people, including two women, have lost their lives in six separate road mishaps.

The mishap on November 24 last on Sunamganj-Sylhet road left a private-car-owner Nurul Haque 45 dead. Pedestrians - Rizia, Baishnabi and Abdul Khalegue - were run over and killed by speedy buses on November 26, November 30 and December 2 respectively.

During the period, a number of vehicles were damaged and traffic was halted by agitated local people following the accidents.

Latest road-blockade came after the death of Abdul Khaleque on the Sylhet-Sunamganj road on December 2 left in which a good number of vehicles were damaged by angry mob and traffic was halted for about two hours. However, police took the custody of two damaged vehicles.

Local people have urged the concerned authorities to take measures against the reckless driving and overloading of vehicles to ensure safety of public life and property.



of the district. DPHE has distributed 5039 latrines in sadar thanas, 4980 latrines in Sripur thana, 5065 latrines in Shalikha thana and 4022 latrines in Muhammadpur thana to control pollution.

Talking to ATM Abdul Matin. Estimator of DPHE Magura, it was learnt that they have undertaken a plan to install and resink 441 tubewells in the district in the current financial year. It was also learnt that DPHE will install and resink 127 tubewells
