Jessore customs earns Tk 279 cr revenue

JESSORE, Dec 13: During first five months of current fiscal, Jessore Office of Commissioner, Customs, Excise and VAT, earned revenues worth Taka 279 crore 79 lakh from different heads of income within its jurisdiction, said a source.

According to the source, out of total earnings. Taka 231 crore 43 lakh came from Benapole and Darshana customs stations. It included VAT supplementary tax, advance income tax. Licence fee and miscellaneous fees. This earning was Taka 73 crore 68 lakh more and increased by 46.71 per cent than that of the same period of last fiscal. This figure was also Taka 20 crore 24 lakh more than the estimated budget for this period, the source said.

When contacted, Commissioner, Customs, Excise and VAT. Jessore. MA Kashem told The Daily Star that this revenue income not only exceeded the record of the same period of last fiscal but it also was all time high.

Giving head-wise earnings of the period he said that Taka 113 crore 87 lakh was collected as import duty. Taka 85 crore 47 lakh as VAT. Taka one crore 77 lakh as supplementary tax, and Taka six crore 2 lakh as miscellaneous tax, Taka 14 crore 43 lakh as advance income tax and Taka nine crore 87 lakh as licence fee.

Another source said that Taka 48 crore 28 lakh was earned as VAT, supplementary tax. Turnover tax from indigenous products and service charges during the period under review.

This figure was Taka 12 crore 44 lakh more and up by 34.61 per cent than that of the same period of last fiscal. It was also Taka three crore 98 lakh more than the budget estimate of this period, being up by 4.98 per cent, the source said.

In the markets both in the town and rural areas the imports of new rice are being increasing day by day, but yet its prices persisting at high level and selling between Taka 12 and 15 per kilogram. The aman paddy is selling at exorbitant prices between Taka 290 and Taka 320 per maund in the mar-

Meanwhile, following high prices of aman rice and paddy the government drive to procure aman crop during the current season could not yield success as yet.

The procurement rates of rice is Taka 11 and paddy Taka 7 per kilogram, which are much below the market

There are further reports that the marginal and poor

farmers could not lift the aman yield in their residences since most of them due to poverty sold the crop in advance well ahead its harvesting season. The daily wages of the day

labourers have also come down below fifty per cent and now a day labourer is hardly earning about Taka 20 a day. The scarcity of job opportunities is also prevailing in the rural areas.

The government initiatives to create job opportunities by introducing test relief and food for work programmes are completely inadequate.

On the other hand, the mass publicised agriculture rehabilitation programme is yet to be executed in the district due to unknown reasons although a fund of Taka 25 lakh meant for the purpose is lying idle with the district administration since one month.
