Tale of Roadside Tailors

A group of non-descript tailors on part of the pavement in the Nilkhet-Babupura area have not much of a conspicuous existence. They present an on incongruous sight in the midst of a crowded assembly of photo-copy

In such a gathering, this group of roadside tailors unobtrusively carry on their trade. They attract a class of people mainly of small means who seek to have some tailoring work of minor nature at economy rates. Such work is not normally entertained at regular tailoring establishments. Even if they do, the rates charged by them for such work appear prohibitive to the small clients. This mainly explains the attraction of these roadside tailors for people of small means. The work of these tailors, by and large, relates to stitching of lunghis, repairs/alternation of various types of garments. Making of new garments of any kind rarely comes within the ambit of their work. On the other hand, the alteration element comprises a big share of their work in view of the situation that the people who buy second-hand old clothes come to these

father suddenly died, leaving the burden of his family on him. Thereafter, with the help of an uncle, he came over to Dhaka and with the proceeds from sale of a small part of the small family land, he could manage to buy a second-hand sewing machine and with it he got a foothold in his present business on the

His present occupation yields a daily income of Tk 50 to Tk 70 on an average. This somehow helps him to keep his body and soul together, besides the compulsion to make some saving to help other members of

Azim's case is typical of the class of roadside tailors in that area. They are all engaged in the bitter struggle for existence in the hard realities of city life. Though their daily average income is low on account of competition from similarly placed tailors, their business has a steady character, because the number of people of small means has been growing by leaps and bounds and they con-

Though they seem to carry on as a sort of flotsam and jetsam entity in the city life, they don't seem to be deficient in a sense of pride on account of their being self-employed and independent. The vagaries of nature take
