Intra-SAARC political tensions should go

NEW DELHI, Dec 18: The seven-nation SAARC today entered its second decade with a stirring call by Prime Minister PV Narasimha Rao to tackle "head on" the scourge of poverty and enhance intra-region trade manifold, even as it remained divided on keeping out bilateral contentious issues at the regional forum, reports PTI. Rao, who is the current

SAARC chairman, in his inaugural address at the 10th anniversary of the SAARC, said the benefit of liberalisation of economies of the SAARC countries should reach their entire population so that South Asia did not remain a 'backwater' in a swiftly changing world.

The anniversary celebra-

tions were marked by a special session of the SAARC foreign minister who vowed to remove poverty from the face of South Asia by 2002 and to take steps for creation of a South Asian Free Trade Area (SAFTA).
