APSU BAU leaders demand withdrawal of 'false cases'

All Party Students Unity (APSU), Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) unit, Thursday demanded withdrawal of "false cases" lodged by anti-liberation Jamaat-Shibir clique against the APSU leaders and immediate release of the arrested.

Addressing a rally in front of the Jatiya Press Club in the afternoon, the student leaders also demanded immediate reopening of BAU. The university was closed following a clash of the campus on December 16 that left three students killed.

Presided over by the Jatiyatatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) BAU unit, president Hasan Jafr Tuhin, the rally was addressed by Samajtantrik Chhatra Front general secretary Nurul Islam, Chhatra Union general secretary Aslam Khan, Chhatra Maitree General secretary Ziaul Haq Zia, JCD Dhaka University unit president ABM Mosharrar Hossain and Chhatra League (S-P) leader Hasanuzzaman Zubir.
