SEA's booming economies appear ready to cool

SINGAPORE. Dec 24: Southeast Asia's booming economies appear ready to cool as they enter 1996 after a year dominated by fears of overheating, reports AFP.

Economists tip a welcome soft landing with lower inflation for Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines. Singapore and Thailand, with a correction of overheating symptoms that have clouded regional stock markets.

"I would think the fear of overheating was the main theme in the region this said Eddie Lee, Regional Chief Economist of Vickers Ballas investment research in Singapore.

Next year we will have increasing evidence that they have started to cool," said Lee, who expects the Singapore bourse to lead a regional charge in 1996 on strong

economic fundamentals. His forecast is in line with a prediction by Merrill Lynch Far East, which sees key South East Asian economies headed for a period of less rapid growth but no pronounced cyclical slowdown. Merrill Lynch sees 1996

gross domestic product (GDP) growth moderating to 6.5-7.0 per cent for Indonesia, 8.0-8.5 per cent for Malaysia, 7.0-7.5 per cent for Singapore and 7.5-8.0 per cent for Thailand

Fears of an imminent increase in domestic oil prices and an expanded value-added tax due to come into force next year cast a shadow on the economy.

Thailand suffered severe nation-wide floods, causing food prices to shoot up. Inflation stood at 5.7 per cent year on year in the first 11 months of 1995, up from 5.1 per cent for all of 1994

Its current account deficit was expected to reach 12.4 billion dollars, or 7.5 per cent of its GDP, in 1995

The Thai central bank has restricted commercial bank credit extension, foreign currency loans and lending to non-productive sectors by raising reserve requirements and setting growth limits.

US airline's non-stop service to China

DETROIT, Dec 24: Northwest Airlines will begin non stop service three times weekly from Detroit to Beijing in April, the first nonstop service by an American airline to China, the US Transportation Department announced, reports AP.

Two more flights would be added in 1998 or 1999 under the agreement, reached after four rounds of negotia tions that concluded Saturday in Beijing.

It also allows China Southern Airlines to serve the West Coast of the United States with nonstop service from

The turnover in volume fell by 42 per cent to 1171 from 2010 and value declined by 20 per cent to Tk 1.93 lakh from Tk 2.44 lakh.

The CSE All Securities Price Index ended at 410.06. National Polymer was the leading gainer of the day with a rise of Tk 3.33 per share while Ctg Cement was the only loser of the day with a decrease of Tk 11.50 per share.

Janata Insurance was the volume leaders of the day having 380 shares traded.

A total numbers of 12 issues were traded during the day, of which seven issues gained, one incurred loss while prices of remaining four issues were unchanged.


