### NTRAMS implementing employment generating academic courses

SIRAJGANJ, Dec 26: The National Training and Research Academy for Multilingual Shorthand (NTRAMS) of Bogra has been playing a vital role in implementing employment generating academic courses including Secretarial Science with emphasis on Multilingual Shorthand, an unique system for writing shorthand in any language with only 22 selected strokes since its inception in 1982.

It was learnt that Abdul Mannan Sarker, Founder-Director of the Academy established the institution on March 29 in 1982 and was run as a private institution for four years in a rented house of Nawabbari Road and introduced Secretarial Science training course and other related subjects. In 1986, the government took up the Academy as a pilot project considering its service importance and usefulness as employment generating project and sanctioned Tk 67.80 lakh for its development. The Academy was later transferred to the Revenue head of the government as an autonomous institution after ending the project period. The Ministry of Education, meanwhile, has undertaken a special development project to instal 1360 computer sets to extend computer training facilities upto thana level taking 460 private institutions at the estimated cost of Tk 31.25 crore through NTRAMS.

In order to adopt modern system of education, Very Small Aperture Terminal (VSAT) was installed to provide the students and trainees with the internationally accepted communication facility through education and research network.

Six years ago, the Academy was entrusted with teaching of Secretarial Science with special emphasis on Multilingual Shorthand and research. With passage of time it has turned into the biggest centre for computer training and research in the country. In September 1995, the NTRAMS successfully completed an international workshop on computer network in education. After the workshop, decision of extending computer network through VSAT was taken up.

So far, 18,000 students, unemployed youngmen and women were trained from the Academy. Out of the total, 6,000 students completed two years' course of Diploma in Commerce. A considerable number of trained unemployed youths were employed in different institutions in home and abroad. The Academy have also published 34 text and reference books. At present, the NTRAMS have several courses of education and training which include one month course to extend training facilities for the officers of government and private offices, 15-day course for secondary school teachers, two months course for employees of both the government and private offices three months training course for university and college teachers, two years Diploma course in Commerce equivalent to HSC course and HSC Business Administration course.

While visiting the Academy recently it was observed that the physical infrastructure of the institution include multistorey building with a charming and well-decorated campus. All the amenities are available within the campus and no student or trainee feel any need to go out for any requirement. The Academy complex stands by the side of North Bengal highway at Bogra. The authorities of the academy have plans to extend the academic works in other fields including higher education in Business Administration and Secretarial Science.

When contracted, Abdul Mannan Sarker told this correspondent that establishment of few more such institutions in the country may provide technical educational assistance to the youths for getting easy employment in different sectors.

### Sugar worth Tk 19 lakh unsold Mobarakganj Sugar Mills may face loss this yr again

JHENIDAH, Dec 26: Mobarakganj Sugar Mills is apprehended to face further loss this year as at least 68.50 metric tons of sugar worth Taka about 19 lakh is lying unsold in the stores of the mills.

According to sources, last year Mobarakganj Sugar Mills produced 22,480 metric tons of sugar and the recovery rate of sugar was 8.45 per cent. The mill continued its production for 226 days instead of targeted 190 days. Due to supply of smuggled Indian sugar in the markets, machinery troubles and import of sugar, the mills could not sell entire sugar which they produced last year. At this the mills faced troubles as they could not pay the prices of sugarcane to the cultivators in time.

Sources said, in the current season the mills started its production on November 3 this year. The authorities had fixed their target to produce 22,087 metric tons of sugar crushing 70 lakh maunds of sugarcane this season. The recovery rate of sugar was fixed at 8.45 per cent. But in 11 days the mills produced only 433 metric tons of sugar crushing 25,182 maund of sugarcane. The recovery rate of sugar was 6.20 per cent only.

**Two alleged criminals held**

MOULVI BAZAR, Dec 26: Two alleged criminals were arrested by the Kotwali police of Hobigonj district recently.

Police sources said, Izzat Ali of Kanjur area was arrested from Sayestanagar Bazar of Hobigonj town for lifting a cow.

Another Abdul Awal, 25, was arrested from a Cinema Hall of Hobigonj town on the same day for his alleged involvement with terrorism.

Later, the arrested criminals were sent to Hobigonj district jail.

Seven persons also charged in the case were found innocent and released while Anul Haq, Ismail Hossain and Abdul Matin were awarded three years rigorous imprisonment.

**District council undertakes 44 development schemes**

COMILLA, Dec 26: The district council has taken up 44 development schemes at a cost of Tk 1.87 crore for the current fiscal year, official sources said, reports UNB.

Of the total, 19 schemes will be implemented costing Tk 97 lakh sanctioned by the government while the rest 25 schemes will be implemented spending Tk 90 lakh from the council's own fund.
