Bangladesh Federation of Film Societies has arranged a special programme today on the occasion of 100 years of cinema.  
On this day in 1895, the first film of the world — "The Gardener Watered" by Louis Lumiere and Auguste Lumiere — was screened in Paris.  
To mark the day, a discussion on 'Cinema in 100th year' will be held at the Indian High Commission auditorium in the city at 5:00 pm.  
Poet Shamsur Rahman will be present as chief guest and Prof Mustafa Nurul Islam and Syeed Ahmed as special guests.  
Following the discussion, Satyajit Ray's film 'Ashani Sangket' (Distant Thunder) will be shown.

Our DU Correspondent adds: The Dhaka University Film Society (DUFS) has drawn up an year-long programme to mark the day. The programme will be inaugurated at 11 am today with a colourful rally.

The rally will start from the Shahbagh road island and will parade different thorough fares of the city. DUFS officials disclosed this at a press conference yesterday at the Jatiya Press Club lounge.  
The year-long programme also includes laying foundation of the film centennial memorial sculpture tomorrow, foreign film session in December next and screening of films in divisional towns.  
A number of seminars on film will also be held throughout the year.
