

Indian govt effort to privatise telecom system faces setback

NEW DELHI, Jan 2: The Indian government's efforts to privatise the telephone system received another setback yesterday when a second round of tenders fell short of expectations...

Industry sources said the reserve price fixed by the government for the second round of tenders was apparently too high and had scared away many potential investors.

Foreign investment in telecom will now be hard to come by, he said. The reserve prices fixed by the government were on the high side and now it will have to either scale them down or go for a third round of tenders.

Total market capital declined to Tk 5308.47 cr from Tk 5336.32 cr.

The leading gainer of the day was Monno Ceramic with a rise of Tk 18.91 per share while the losers were led by 2nd ICB MF and Square Pharma losing Tk 30.00 per share.

The volume leaders of the day were Beximco Pharma (18350) and Ashraf Textile (7000).
