Applications are invited from local individuals and/or established firms for the positions of 5 (five) short-term National Consultants on contract basis in the project 'Support for Monitoring Sustainable Human Development in Bangladesh' under Socio-Economic Infrastructure Division of Planning Commission. The successful candidates will be required to prepare papers on the issues mentioned below along with other descriptions of the assignments respectively.

TOR, educational qualification & experience

TOR: To write a paper on SHD Conceptualisation in Bangladesh: The paper should trace and critically analyse the evolution of SHD concept, identify its holistic nature, and distinction from other socio-economic definitions of development, and hence examine this concept from the Bangladesh perspectives, its relevance to policy-making, and identify priority pattern of development objectives. The paper should be submitted within 2 (two) months from the date of contract.

Qualification and Experience: Ph.D. in any discipline under Social Science from a recognised university. Experience & documentary evidence of analytical skill in the related topics is essential.

TOR: To conduct a short sample survey and prepare a report on Sustainable Human Development from the poor's perspective: The paper will be an attempt to conceptualize the SHD as perceived by the poor and vulnerable groups, using a well tailored small (albeit representative) sample survey using PRA. The paper should be submitted within 1.5 (one and half) months from the date of contract.

Qualification and Experience: Ph.D. in any discipline under Social Science/ Statistics from a recognised university. Experience & documentary evidence of analytical skill in poverty analysis and conducting sample survey and PRA session independently is essential.

TOR: To write a review paper on institutional arrangement and capacity for implementation of SHD: The paper should identify and examine the functional linkages of all primary institutions involved directly and indirectly in planning, implementing and monitoring SHD. The paper must explore modalities of institutional arrangements for sustainability of participation in planning, mobilization of resources and monitoring HD. The paper should be submitted within 2 (two) months from the date of contract.

Qualification and Experience: Ph.D. in Economics/Political Science/Public Administration from a recognised university. Experience & documentary evidence of analytical skill in related topics is essential.

TOR: To prepare a review paper on sources of data for modelling: The paper should address current work on monitoring various SHD indicators in Bangladesh and assessment of sources of data; data availability for constructing Social Accounting Matrix and SHD modelling including demographic data and vital statistics & surveys, agricultural and industrial surveys, social services statistics environment surveys, trade and balance of payments, input/output and national income accounts. The paper should be submitted within 2 (two) months from the date of contract.

Qualification and Experience: Ph.D. in Economics/Statistics from a recognised university. Experience & documentary evidence of primary data-based analytical skill in poverty analysis, modelling, etc. is essential.

TOR: To prepare a review paper on past models and modelling experiences: The paper should (a) review the type of economic models used in Bangladesh in the past decade, including model specifications and data requirements; (b) assessment of the experience gained in application of the models; (c) identification of the current status of the models; (d) assessment of their policy relevance; (e) recommendation of an appropriate modelling approach and specification for SHD planning & monitoring. The paper should be submitted within 2 (two) months from the date of contract.

Qualification and Experience: Ph.D. in Economic/Statistics from a recognised university. Experience & documentary evidence of model building is essential.

Honorarium will be fixed on negotiation with the selected candidate to the aforesaid assignments. Application must reach the above address within 7 days from the date of advertisement. The candidates should submit an outline of the proposed work along with their respective applications.

3 die in separate incidents

A speech impaired teenaged boy who was reportedly injured in an explosion while making bombs Friday night, succumbed at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) yesterday morning.

The deceased Omar, 19, of Dhanla road in Demra thana area, was admitted to the DMCH late Friday with fatal injuries.

Another youngman, Hasan, 28, of the same area was also injured in the blast during the making of bombs. He was under treatment at the DMCH till last night, medical sources said.

Omar's brother Osman said that Hasan called his brother from their house Friday evening and took him to a nearby house for helping him to manufacture bomb.

However, Demra police said last night that they did not have any information about the incident.

Meanwhile, one Motiur Rahman, 35, was killed after

falling from a speeding bus on the airport road in the city at around noon yesterday. In another incident Zakir Hossain, 20, was electrocuted while working in a garments factory at Green road Tuesday night, hospital sources said.
