"MINEP gaining confidence of people"

BARGUNA, Jan 12: An extensive mass education programme of Islamic Foundation (IF), Bangladesh, is going on in full swing in three villages of Betagi thana in this southern district, reports UNB.

The foundation introduced the programme in 1993 under its Mosque-based Integrated Non-formal Education Programme (MINEP) with a view to ensure education for all within the year 2000.

The programme has gained confidence of the grass-root level people of the three villages in the thana", said M Mahbubul Alam, Assistant Director of IF here.

He said that the number of people interested to the MINEP at Betagi was also increasing day by day.

According to IF officials, at present more than 500 juvenile and adults are taking primary and religious education through 18 non-formal schools set up at the villages.

Students of the programme, aged between 5 to 35, are facilitated with free educational materials supplied by IF authorities.

Officials said a good number of girl students have also been included in MINEP in Betagi. According to them three libraries have been set for the programme at the thana.

Eighteen imams have also been appointed for making the programme a success. The imams were given proper training prior to their appointment.

Generally, Bengali, Mathematics and Arabic are taught at the MINEP schools and only students aged between 6 and 10 are facilitated with English course.

The MINEP in Betagi is scheduled to be concluded in December next. But, officials said, duration of this programme may be extended for yielding better result.

The Islamic Foundation, Bangladesh, introduced the MINEP at one village in every district throughout the country and the programme has already achieved 80 per cent success.

Alleged activist of outlawed party held in Satkhira

High quality cotton can be produced in Chuadanga, Meherpur regions

CHUADANGA, Jan 12: Cotton cultivation has a bright prospect in Chuadanga and Meherpur districts, cotton experts observed saying that the cotton produced in this region is of a improved quality and the production rate is also up to the mark.

During the current cotton cultivation season a total of 8,545 acres of land have been cultivated in Chuadanga zone of the Cotton Development Board (CDB). The Chuadanga zone of CDB consists of all the four thanas of Chuadanga district like Chuadanga sadar, Alamdanga, Damurhuda and Jibannagar and Meherpur sadar thana of Meherpur district.

There are seventeen units in the zone like Daulatganj,

Jibannagar, Andulbaria, Karpashdanga, Damurhuda, Dingedah, Sarajganj, Munshigang, Alamdanga, Alokdia, Asmankhali, Baradi, Meherpur, Kederganj, Maha-jampur, Jagannathpur and Chuadanga sadar.

In the meantime harvesting of cotton in this zone have started. It is expected that during the current season a total of 2,66,721 maunds of seed-cotton worth Taka 25 crores would be produced in Chuadanga zone. While 90,685 maunds of minus seeds would be produced.

The local zonal officer of the CDB told this correspondent that the soil of Chuadanga and Meherpur districts are very suited to

cotton cultivation. The cotton which are being produced in this zone are very high in quality and standard he added. He further told that the farmers of Chuadanga and Meherpur districts are now very much eager and interested in cotton cultivation. He also said that during this year three varieties of cotton have been cultivated in Chuadanga zone like DL-50, DL-90 and Tago-93/94. He said about 35 maunds of lint cotton are being produced in an acre of land and the price of one seer lint cotton Taka 75.00 i.e. Taka 2874 per maund.

The cotton cultivation season begins in the month of July and concludes by August. While the harvesting of cot-

ton begins in the month of November and concludes by the month of February every year.

The local zonal Cotton Development Officer further told this correspondent that the interest to cultivate cotton among the common farmers are increasing very rapidly in this zone because cotton is a very profitable crop. He said that the demand of cotton has abnormally increased as a result the cotton cultivators has no suffering to sale their cotton.

It was learnt that if a massive cotton cultivation programme is taken up in the region then huge quantity of foreign exchange could be saved every year.

Nephews chop uncle to death in B'baria

BRAHMANBARIA, Jan 12: Zillur Rahman, 55, of Natal village under Brahmanbaria sadar thana of the district was chopped to death by his three nephews (the sons of his younger brother) recently.



In adjustment (1) of question no 9 it is found that in Bengali version Tk 19,000 was spent to purchase a new machine. In English version of the same question, amount of money was not stated. The candidates faced serious confusion due to such discrepancy.
