AF Mujibur Rahman award

The first AF Mujibur Rahman Award for Mathematics was given to Md Shaukat Ali who stood First Class First in the B.Sc honours examination of 1993 (held in 1995) by DU acting Vice-Chancellor Professor Shahiduddin Ahmed at a freshers' day reception held at the Department yesterday.

AF Mujibur Rahman was the first Bengali Muslim ICS officer and was nominated for selection to that distinguished cadre by Sir Ashutosh Mukherjee whose feat he eclipsed by attaining First Class First in the M.Sc (Pure Mathematics) examination from Calcutta University in 1923. Rahman died in 1945, at the age of 46, when he was about to become a judge of the Calcutta High Court.

Confce on Aga Khan Award Importance of preserving old bldgs stressed

Speakers at a conference in the city yesterday observed that the Aga Khan Award for Architecture is contributing towards unearthing the 'neglected' and 'unrecognised' cultural heritage of third world nations especially of the Muslim majority countries, reports BSS.

They were speaking at the conference on 'The Aga Khan Award for Architecture'. Mehet Doruk Pamir, an internationally reputed architect attended the conference as the main speaker while Lailunnahar Ekram conducted.

Majharul Islam, ex-chief architect of PWD, Shah Alam Zahiruddin, Head of the Department of Architecture of BUET Mir Mobasher Ali, and president of the Institute of Architects Shamsul Wares took part in the discussions.

The award was set up in 1977 while the first cycle of awards, valued at half a million dollars, was given in 1980. The sixth cycle of awards was given last year to 12 organisations. In Bangladesh 'Sangsad Bhaban' and the housing projects of poor farmers, modelled by the 'Grameen Bank' were the two organisations which received the coveted awards.

Speaking on the occasion Mehet Doruk Pamir underlined the importance of preservation of old cities and buildings having rich architectural heritage. 'Historic sites can be more valuable than museums,' he said, adding that under Aga Khan Award much can be done for revitalisation of old architectural heritage of the Muslim countries.

Architect Majharul Islam, who was the member of the first jury board of Aga Khan Award, said that most of our societies have lost touch with past architectural glory because of long colonial subjugation. 'We are forced to forget our architectural heritage and take lesson on western architecture' he said.

Architect Zahiruddin said that Aga Khan Award has opened an opportunity for Bangladeshi architects to mix and exchange ideas with their foreign counterparts about the most recent development in architectural designing and other aspects of the pursuit.

Mir Mobasher Ali said that Aga Khan Award would leave a far-reaching effect on the development of architecture in Bangladesh. Shamsul Wares said Aga Khan Award is a noble venture towards providing identity and cultural continuity of the Muslim.
