

19-pt package to speed up Chakma repatriation

The government has announced the 19-point package programme to accelerate repatriation of the tribal refugees from the Indian state of Tripura, reports BSS.

According to an official handout issued Sunday in view of these facilities 5186 tribal refugees of 1027 families have already returned to their homes under government initiatives while 1721 of 451 families have come back on personal or unofficial initiatives.

The 19-point package includes assurance of guarantee of life and property of the repatriated refugees as per Constitution and the law of the land, rehabilitation in the refugees on their own land, provide rations free of cost upto six months. Taka 10,000 as one time grant for house building and agriculture, two bundles of corrugated iron sheet, permit of wood, Taka 8,000 for buying one pair of bullock for cultivation, exemption of agricultural loans and other facilities for education and getting government services.

Communications Minister Oli Ahmed visited the refugee camps in Tripura last year and urged them to return home.

FEMA expresses disappointment

The Fair Election Monitoring Alliance (FEMA) yesterday expressed disappointment as the upcoming parliamentary elections will be held without the participation of the major opposition parties, says a press release.

FEMA was formed last July to monitor the elections. It expresses disappointment as it has neither got official confirmation from the Election Commission nor has it received government approval of its election monitoring proposal.

Int'l workshop on refugee law

Speakers at the concluding session of a two-day workshop yesterday emphasised on enacting legislation for regulating refugee and migratory issues.

The workshop on International Refugee Law, jointly organised by the Refugee and Migratory Movements Research Unit (RMMRU) and UNHCR was held at the Planning and Development Academy auditorium in the city.

The course started on January 20 was participated by some 40 students of the Dhaka University.

The concluding session was addressed by Dr Chowdhury Rafiqul Abrar, coordinator of RMMRU and the Chairman of the Department of International Relations, DU. Dr Mizanur Rahman, associate professor of the Law Department and Saad Al Attar, deputy representative of RMMRU.

Dr Abrar said, refugee and migratory issues have some bearing in present-day international relations.

He informed that RMMRU would arrange a further 46-hour workshop on refugee laws this year.

Dr Mizanur Rahman said, we should have some knowledge about refugee laws as a conscious citizen.

Refugees are also human beings. As such they also deserve dignity, he added.

Saad Al Attar emphasised on the incorporation of specific legislation on refugee and migratory issues.
