## Ban on student politics at SUST extended

SYLHET, Jan 31: The Shahjalal University of Science and Technology (SUST) has extended the period of keeping the varsity free from political activities.

The SUST authorities yesterday extended the period till March 31 this year.

The university was closed since die after a series of clashes between rival student organisations on June 30 last year.

The institution was re-opened on August 1 and all types of political activities like processions, meetings, rallies, strikes and poster were declared banned on the campus for three months. It was again extended till January 31.

The SUST syndicate in a meeting held the previous day with VC Professor Syed Mohibuddin Ahmed in the chair decided to extend the date further with a view to take different examinations in time.

## Incident at Sonargaon Hotel slated

The Bangladesh Employers' Association (BEA) yesterday expressed concern over the incident at the Sonargaon Hotel Tuesday and urged the government to take action against those who were involved in the attack on the management executives of the hotel, reports BSS.

The association observed that the incident had not only demoralised the hotel management but also scared its guests. Reportedly, the tensions are still prevailing for which, management personnel suffer from sense of insecurity.

Dr. Syed Shamsuddin Mahmud, a retired medical officer of the Water Development Board (WDB), died of a cardiac arrest yesterday at the PG Hospital. He was 72, reports BSS.
