The government has taken elaborate programmes to celebrate the holy Eid-ul-Fitre an official handout said in Dhaka yesterday, reports

A high-level inter-ministerial meeting on observance of the Eid-ul-Fitr was held yesterday at the conference room of the Ministry of Religious Affair with State Minister for Religious Affairs Prof MA Mannan in the chair.

Secretary of the ministry Mohammad Abdul Hannan, additional secretary of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs AKM Farooque and high officials of different ministries concerned were present in the meeting.

President Abdur Rahman Biswas and Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia will give messages to the nation on this occasion.

The main Eid congregation would be held at the national Eid gah maidan at 8 am. In case of inclement weather, it would be held at the Baitul Mokarram National Mosque at 8 am.

National flags and buntings inscribed with 'Eid Mubarak' both in Bengali and Arabic will be hoisted by the sides of the thorough fares and road islands from Dhaka Gate at Banani to Bangabhaban.

Bangladesh Television and Radio Bangladesh will telecast special programmes while the newspapers will publish special supplements.

Special diets will be served to the patients jail inmates, children centres, baby homes, vagrant welfare centres and the destitute

welfare centres. After the Eid prayer, Ministry of Information will arrange screening of films and organise cultural functions at

city parks and other areas. Islamic Foundation and Islamic Cultural centres in different districts will arrange seminars and discussions on the significance of the Eid-ul-Fitr.

Children reunion and charity football matches will also be held.

Divisional commissioners, deputy commissioners and thana nirbahi officers will arrange programmes in accordance with the national programmes.

Similarly, Bangladesh missions abroad will also celebrate the day.

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
