B Chy iterates appeal to Opposition Stop anti-election violence

BNP leader AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury Sunday said that the people have been interested in this week's election despite violence let loose by the opposition activists, reports UNB.

"There will be a large turnout of voters, if there is no obstruction," he said. Briefing newsmen on different aspects of the country's 6th parliamentary election on Thursday, the former Deputy Leader of the House expressed his confidence that the polls would be held as scheduled.

The Election Commission (EC) has completed all necessary preparations for holding the polls and adequate measures would be taken for voters to cast their votes freely and fairly.

A member of the BNP standing committee, Chowdhury reiterated his appeal to the opposition parties to stop their anti-election campaigns to let the people exercise their rights of franchise.

He regretted that the country's three main opposition parties which were trying to disrupt the election did not respond to his appeal to give respite to their anti-election campaigns.

Responding to a question, Chowdhury alleged "only a few opposition activists indulged in acts of violence and terrorism... People in general are not with them". Foreign Minister ASM Mostafizur Rahman, Information Secretary Syed Amirul Mulk and Additional Home Secretary Fayezer Rahman Chowdhury were present at the briefing attended by both foreign and local newsmen.

The recently announced BNP election manifesto said it would not renew the treaty signed in Dhaka on March 19, 1972.
