Ajoy Mitra. 29, from Pirojpur, who has just brought out his new cassette, is a music teacher. A teacher now for 10 years. Mitra makes as much Tk 8.000 to Tk 10,000 at month, teaching his pupils four days a week each. Talking about the problems that he faces in his job Mitra says. "My income is flexible and not anything stable. So. I cannot budget."

He says. "There is a philosophical base to the songs of Rabindrashangeet and Uchangoshangeet. l'eople sometimes don't care to

understand the words of the songs. Again, in Bangladesh, an artiste is often not given his proper evaluation. They don't know how to credit a musician and do not take him seriously. There is a music college and there are musical academies but they are not enough and tutors must come up to serve individuals. Many go in for private lessons to get personal attention although tuition fees por private tutors are higher than the cost at musical academies.

He practices three hours a day himself and tells his students to practice for an hour a day. It is people like Mitra who satisfy the musical urge of many in the city so that they fit in their

career with their hobby.




