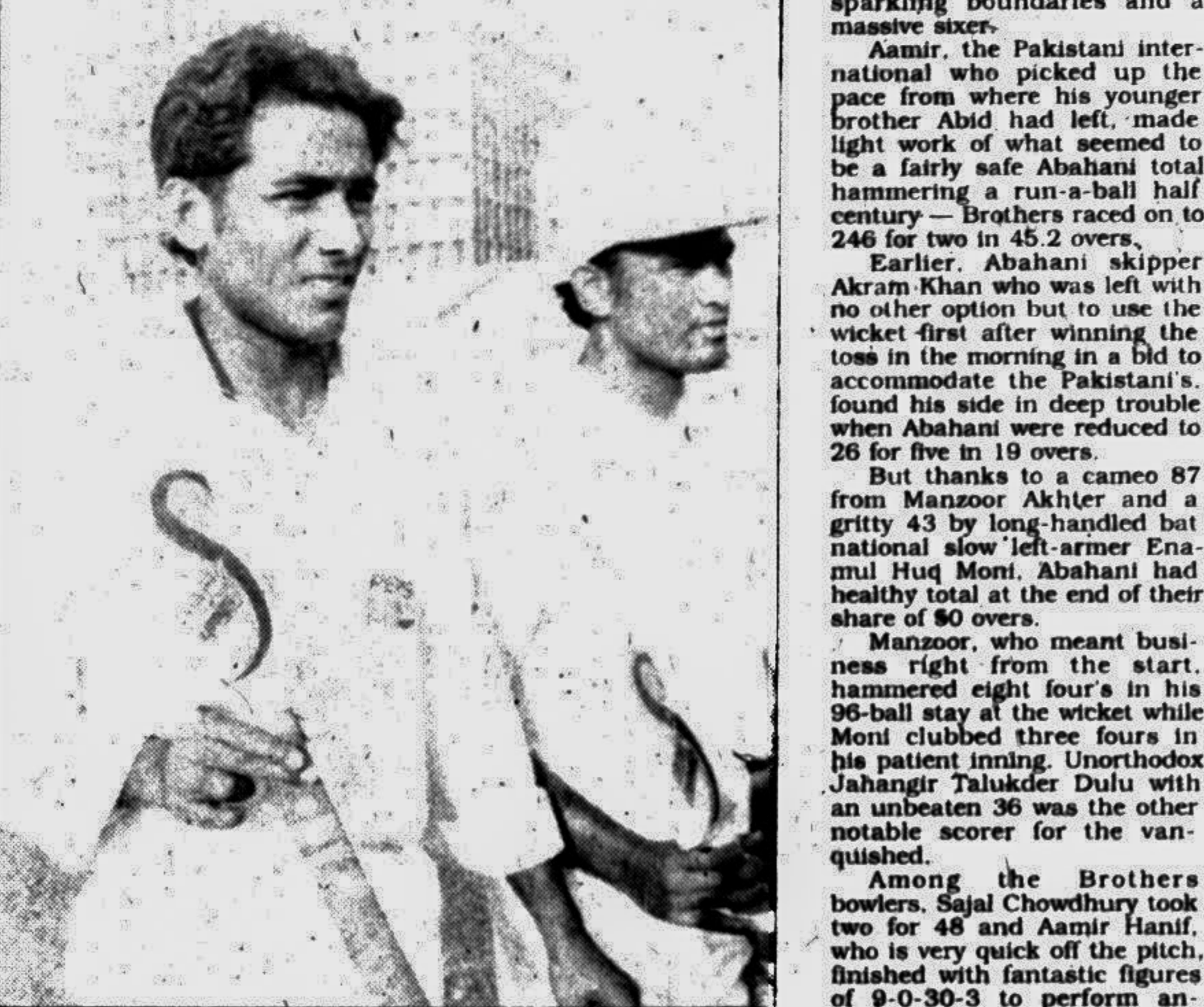

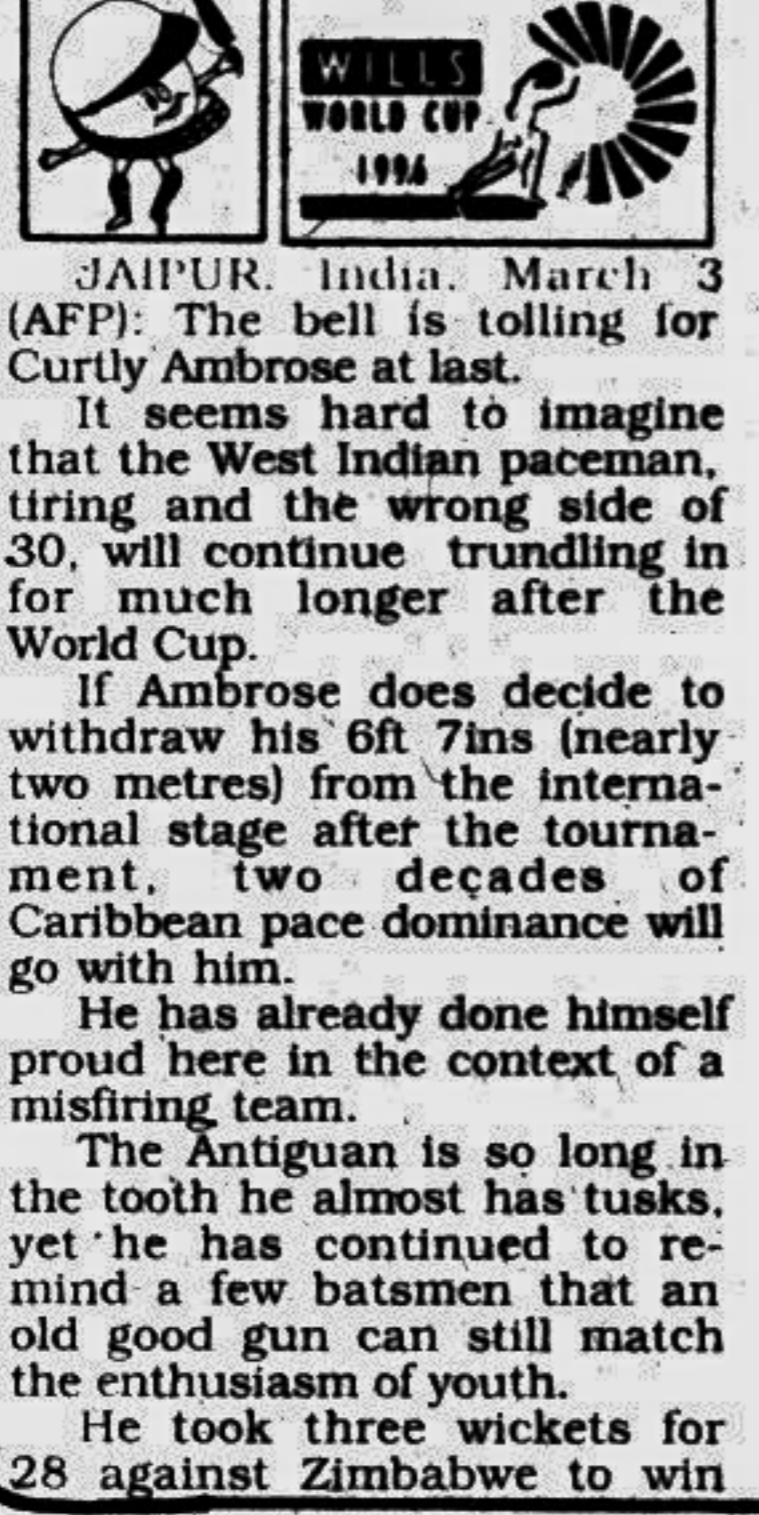
SCOREBOARD World Cup Group B Scoreboard between Pakistan and England at Karachi Sunday.
