Newspapermen threaten greater movement

A joint meeting of the Central Coordination Committee and the Sangram Committee comprising the three federations of the newspaper industry and the Dhaka Union of Journalists was held yesterday at the Jatya Press Club with the convenor of the coordination committee, Fazay Imam in the chair, reports BSS.

A BFUJ press release said, the meeting discussed the issue of dearness allowance for the journalists and employees and different other aspects in the newspaper industry. The meeting expressed deep concern at the government's delay in announcing the dearness allowance.

The meeting observed that the Information Ministry had taken recourse to unnecessary excuses in forming the 5th Wage Board and was now adopting the same dilly-dallying in announcing the dearness allowance.

The meeting warned that if the dearness allowance was not announced immediately the journalists, employees and press workers of the newspaper industry would be compelled to announce programme for greater movement, the press release said.
