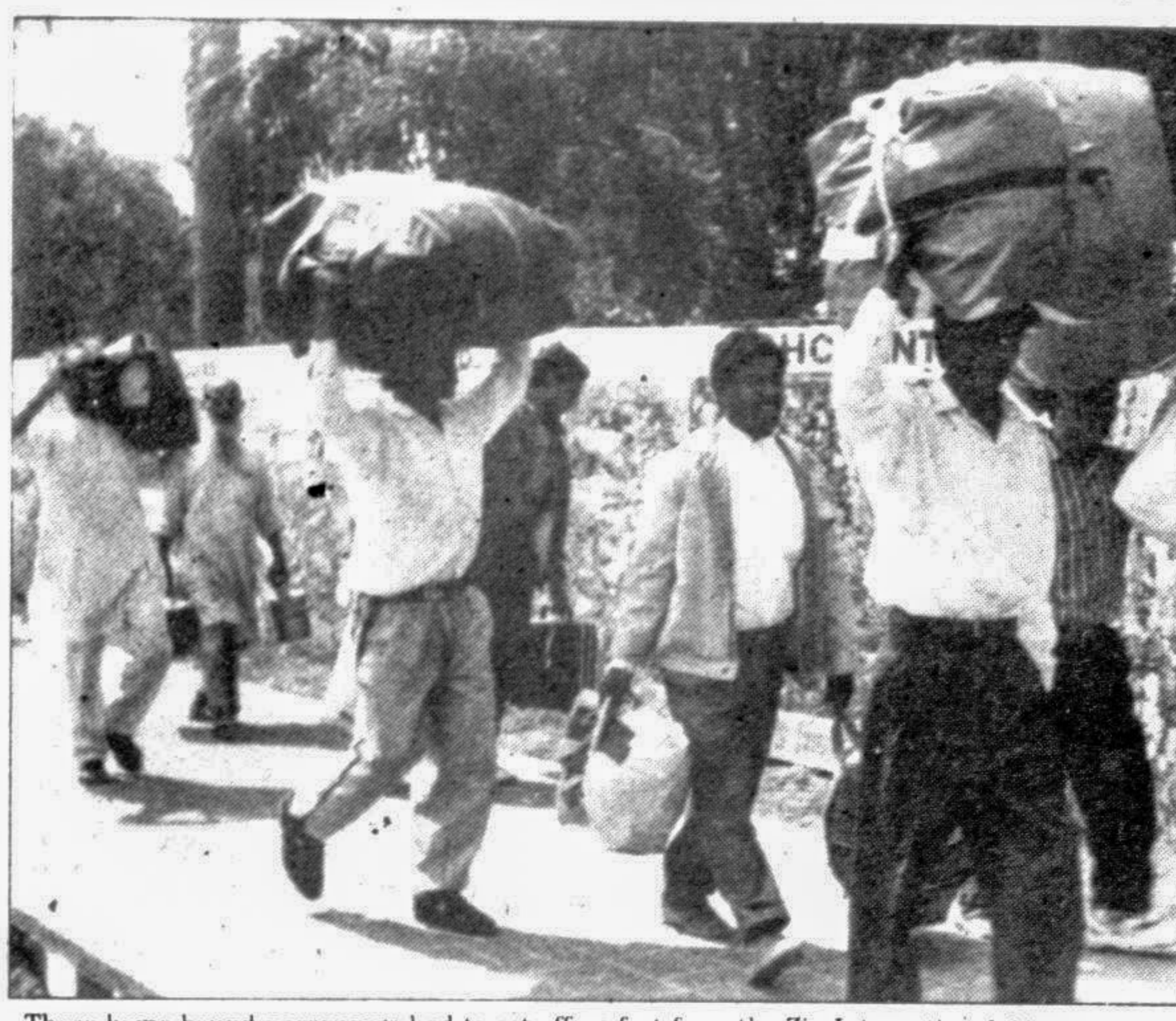

HR body deplors role of Bar Council

Bangladesh Society for the Enforcement of Human Rights (BSEHR) secretary general Sigma Huda yesterday criticised the role of Bangladesh Bar Council "for using it as a platform of political parties," reports BSS.

In a statement, Sigma Huda, who is also a member of the council, said the Bar Council was a registered organisation and the main functions of the institution include giving certificates to the lawyers, conducting legal programmes, regulating code of conduct and ensuring welfare of the lawyers.

She said the political parties had their own platforms and the council should not be used in this respect.

Air neutral news on Radio, TV: SCO

Sammilita Chhatra Oikkayo (SCO), a newly formed students alliance, yesterday held a rally near the office of the National Broadcasting Authority (NBA), a press release said, reports BSS.

They hoped that good sense would prevail and the concerned quarters would refrain from assaulting the reporters and photo-journalists and attacking newspaper offices in the greater interest of democracy and freedom of expression.

Call for vigilance against emergence of racism

The International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination will be observed today in the country as elsewhere in the world with due fervour, reports UNB.

In a message on the eve of the day President Abdur Rahman Biswas has underscored the need for building an equitable world free from all sorts of racial discrimination.

He said respect for individuals and nations without discrimination can contribute to the enhancement of international solidarity, understanding, cooperation, peace and security.

Upholding Bangladesh's support to the efforts of international organisations, including UN, to eliminate the racial discrimination, President Biswas said the international community were playing a significant role towards this objective.

In a separate message, Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia has called for vigilance against emergence of racism and discrimination, including ethnic cleansing.

"We are all now well into the third UN decade to combat racism and racial discrimination," she said.

BFUJ, DUJ slate police action on photojournalists

Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) yesterday condemned and protested the assault of the on duty reporters and photojournalists by the police during Tuesday's Sangsad gherao programme of the Opposition political parties, reports BSS.

In a joint statement BFUJ president Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury and secretary general M Shajahan Mia and DUJ president Abul Kalam Azad and general secretary Azizul Islam Bhuiyan also condemned the bomb attack on Banglar Bani office last night.

Deploing the incidents the BFUJ and DUJ leaders termed the actions as total infringement on freedom of the press. They demanded safety and security of the working journalists and proper action against the offenders.

They hoped that good sense would prevail and the concerned quarters would refrain from assaulting the reporters and photo-journalists and attacking newspaper offices in the greater interest of democracy and freedom of expression.

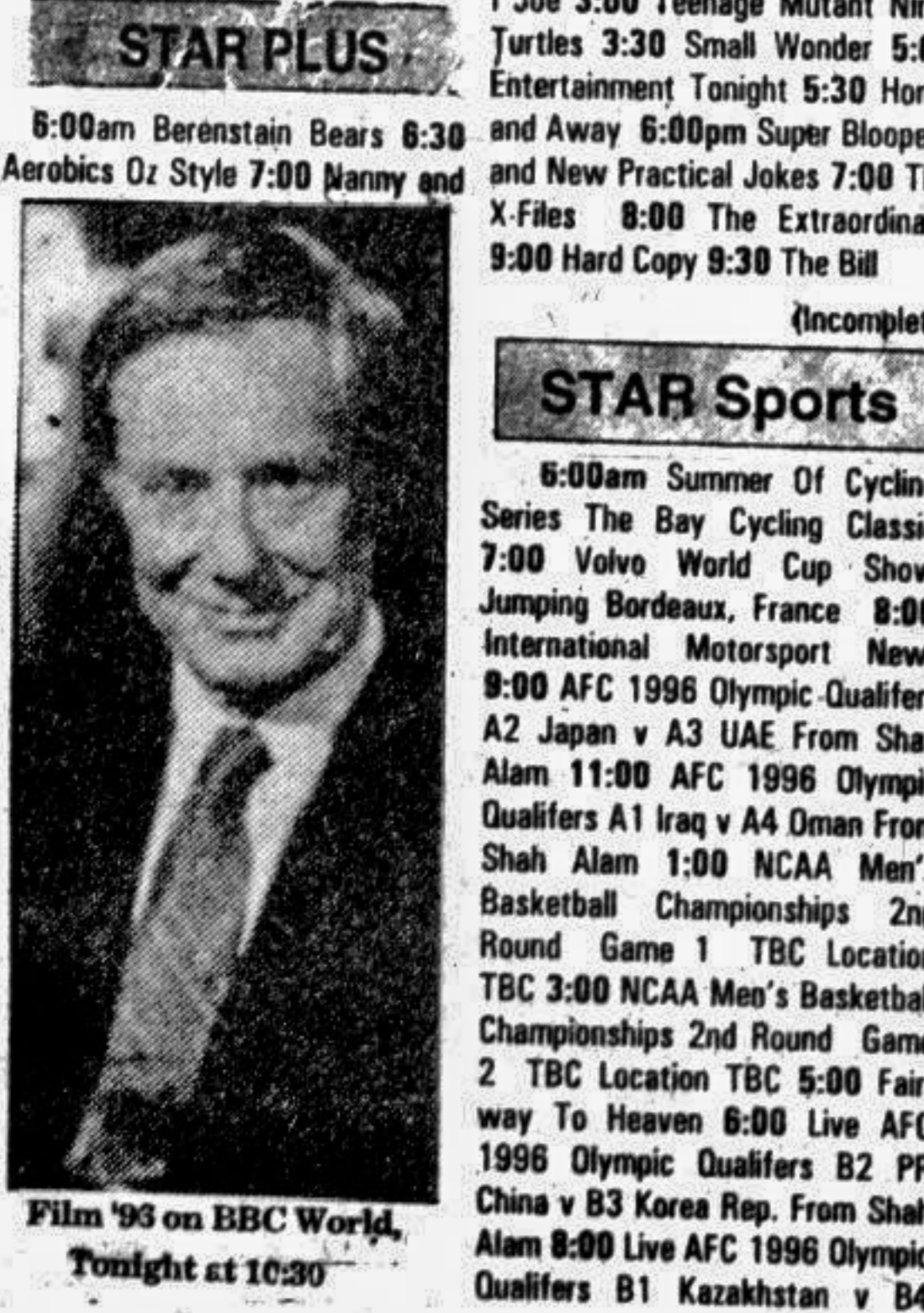
