After serving for a brief spell as a teacher of history at the Sirajganj College and the Jagannath College in Dhaka, he obtained a Burmah-Shell scholarship for studying at Oxford. After obtaining his Oxford degree, he studied law and became a barrister-at-law. In this respect. He is a literary awardee and fellow of Bangla Academy, Asiatic Society of Bangladesh.

After his retirement as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, he used to write articles on various aspects of law in different newspapers' and periodicals.




