Zeb-un-Nessa Jamal was a lyricist who knew how to weave flowers of ideas into beautiful garlands of songs. And with such garlands she adorned her listeners and

She was a lyricist with a profound sense of beauty. This sense of beauty was reflected in her romantic songs. She proved that romantic songs can be written without going into direct wordings. She used to say that the magic in songs is its capacity of touching peoples' hearts!

Perhaps it is better that in Gan Elo More Mone we have only the words and not the tunes for the latter could have screened us from the true talent of Zebun-Nessa Jamal. We have remarkably successful poets but song-writers of the calibre of what Shamsur Rahman or Al-Mahmood is as a poet — are pathetically absent may be be-cause of the lyricist only fulfils a need of the music industry rather than expressing his or her personality for no other inspiration than the pleasure of creation and quest for truth. Let Zeb-un-Nessa Jamal's book of songs greatly add to the recognition of the songwriter's

Another book review in The Bangladesh Observer opined: "Begum Jamal's songs are, however, a refreshing departure. She depicts in a lucid and cadenced style myriad variations in human situations and emotions - in love and in pangs of separation, in pursuit or in rejection, which strike a chord in every human heart."

She transferred herself into child when she wrote songs for children as she knew "That man never grows old who keeps a child in his heart." This is what helped her to deliver her message to the children through her songs as she could speak the language of children

Zeb-un-Nessa made an effort to gather her works in two large volumes of scrap books just two months before her death and named "Chhelekhela." It contains her writings published in various journals, also her precious murals, and the photographs and autographs she gathered from the persons she adored. I end with a translation of

one of her songs "When I shall no more be on this earth/And won't be dreaming of new songs/What if you praise me then/Would that fill my lonely heart. Instead have your say right now/Tell me you adore me, adore my songs/For once gone I won't be back/To measure how much incense was burnt on my grave/Or count the phials of perfumes emptied."

mittee at a meeting here vesterday urged the newly formed caretaker government to impose a ban on the use of religion in election campaign, reports UNB


