


## Tania's solo show opens today

## Shibir attacks JU hall

A group of armed men reportedly belonging to the Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) attacked the Al Beruni hall of the Jahangirnagar University (JU) at around Wednesday midnight.

The gunmen came from the western side of village area of the university and fired around 12 rounds of the gun shots from near the Life Science Institute building adjacent to Al Beruni hall, witnesses said.

Meanwhile, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) in a press release yesterday claimed that the gunmen also fired shots aiming at the JU unit JCD president and Organising Secretary while they were walking near the Life Science Institute.

The JCD held the ICS responsible for the incident.

The JCD also urged the caretaker government to take action against the "attackers and terrorists of the ICS" immediately.

## Reporters' Unity rally today


