Applications are invited from bonafide candidates of Bangladeshi nationals for the post of one 'Law Enforcement Training Consultant' under the Master Plan for Drug Abuse Control in Bangladesh Project, jointly undertaken by the Government of Bangladesh (GOB) and the United Nations, International Drug Control Programmes (UNDCP). Brief description of the terms of reference, required qualification and experience etc. of the said consultant are given below:-

a. Period of Appointment:

Initially 6 months, may be extended, if necessary.

b. Terms of Reference:

- To design and implement drug control training programmes for the Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) Bangladesh Rifles, Police, Customs, Coast Guard.
- To assess the training needs of the DNC and other law enforcement agencies in the basic and specialist training courses.
- To assist in identifying and selecting the participants for both the training courses.
- To prepare a presentation paper on both international and national drug trafficking situation for the participants of the both training courses.
- To assist in organising both the training courses with provision of ensuring logistics and other required support equipments.
- To plan and develop the curriculum for the National Instructors for the basic training course.
- To assist for planning and conducting the training including training of trainers for future workshops.
- Perform such other functions in connection with the law enforcement training and workshops as the DNC may direct.

c. Salary and other allowances:

Salary (Consolidated) will range from Tk. 45,000-55,000/- per month.

d. Required qualifications and experience:

- Minimum graduation degree from a recognized University. Preference will be given to the candidates having higher degree.
- At least 15 years working experience in the relevant field. Preference will be given to the candidates having working experience in the field of drugs/narcotics control.
- Candidates having experience in organising training for members of law enforcement agencies, working knowledge of the law enforcement agencies of Bangladesh at the mid level to senior level management will be given preference.
- Foreign training in intelligence collection, collection and analysis will be an additional qualification.
- Working knowledge of criminal investigation, search and seizure and prosecution, plus knowledge of drug identification is an advantage.
