Free country from illegal arms: BCP

General secretary of the Bangladesh Communist Party Mujahidul Islam Selim yesterday urged the caretaker government to free the country from all sorts of illegal arms and take all terrorists to book in the greater interest of free and fair elections, reports BSS.

Addressing a rally organised by the party in Dhaka, he called for uprooting all evil forces, including mastans and extortionists, as they were deep-rooted in society.

Selim accused the Jamaat Shibir clique of floating a private force of their own and said some big parties were fostering their own cadres with illegal arms. "These forces must be uprooted in the greater national interest," he said.

In 1992, he worked at Prime Minister's Secretariat as Additional Secretary. He was promoted to the rank of Secretary in 1994 and was posted in the Ministry of Disaster Management and Relief.

Round up all terrorists: RUTA

RAJSHAHI, Apr 5: Rajshahi University Teachers' Association (RUTA) has urged the caretaker government for proper initiative to arrest all terrorists for restoring congenial academic atmosphere in the campus, reports UNB.

In a joint statement today (Friday), RUTA president Prof Mohammad Yunus and general secretary Rafiqul Islam said the university was gripped by terrorism since February last year that left several students killed.

Such unwanted incidents of violence were occurring on the campus due to "partisan behaviour" of the university authorities, the statement said.

The RUTA leaders elicited the caretaker government on its assumption of power.

UK Medical Council accredits USTC

MBBS qualification awarded by the University of Science and Technology, Chittagong (USTC) has been accepted by the General Medical Council of Great Britain for limited registration, says a press release.

This will enable the doctors to undertake supervised employment in hospital posts affording educational approved training, such posts are normally at the grade of SRO (senior house officer), registrar and senior registrar.

Limited registration can be granted for periods amounting to a maximum aggregate period of five years.

The MBBS course of USTC is already recognised by the WHO and the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council, added the press release.

2 peace confces in CHT in Apr

The Chittagong Hill Tracts National Coordination and Peace Council will organise two peace conferences in the hill districts this month, reports UNB.

The first conference will be held on April 15 at Ramgarh Town Hall auditorium in Khagrachhari and the second on April 20 at Napiarchar Thana Parishad auditorium in Rangamati.

Both the tribal and non-tribals are expected to attend the conferences to establish peace in the hill areas, said a press release yesterday.

Local government council chairmen of the three hill districts and intellectuals will also attend.

Another report adds: As the living conditions in various camps across the frontier areas of the two neighbouring countries continued to worsen, the outlawed Shantibahini men are preferring to lay down their arms.

Thulia Khul Marmar, a member of the outlawed party, bade farewell to arms four months back with a view to leading a normal life.

"I want peace, not bloodshed," said emotion choked T K Marmar, son of Mirra Thul Marmar of Baramhadak village in Thanchi thana of Bandarban district.

T K Marmar said he had undergone treatment in the Combined Military Hospital after he laid down arms — three SMGs and 85 bullets — along with two of his colleagues, Negeyha Marmar and

Lafra Marmar, on December 14, 1995.

"It's not easy to return home evading the vigils of the Shantibahini men. Earlier our many attempts had been foiled by them," he said.

'BNP' has paved way for holding fair polls

BNP standing committee member and former minister Dr Khandakar Mosharraf Hossain yesterday said his party has created a constitutional way to make all future elections free, fair and neutral, reports UNB.

He was addressing a public meeting at Daudkandi thana parishad ground in Comilla.

He said the present non-party caretaker government is the outcome of the 13th amendment of the Constitution for which the nation will ever remember BNP.

"BNP does not believe in the politics of arms and entente," Dr Mosharraf said adding that "people is the strength of BNP".

The meeting was also addressed by former minister Barrister Rafiqul Islam Mia, former state minister and BGMEA president Redwan Ahmed, central labour secretary of BNP Zafur Hasan and local party leaders.

Redwan Ahmed said the opposition political parties had thrown the garment manufacturing industry of the country into a disastrous situation.
