Indian money market appears unperturbed ahead of polls

BOMBAY, Apr 13: Indian money and foreign exchange markets appear unperturbed ahead of national elections due later this month as major postpoll changes seem unlikely. bankers said yesterday, reports Reuter.

"The economic agenda is almost the same," said the treasurer of a European bank in Bombay, referring to manifestoes of the ruling Congress Party and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), the main opposition challenger.

The elections to the 543member lower house will be spread over five days beginning on April 27 and ending on May 30. Counting in most constituencies begins on May 8.

Both parties have said they are committed to continuing deregulation and liberalisation measures initiated by the present government in 1991.

"If anything, things should get better," said a dealer at a state-run bank, referring to recent steps by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to increase funds with the banking system to ease a shortage of liquidity which is hurting industrial growth

With a new government, the RBI will be more courageous in taking further steps like a fresh cut in CRR (Cash Reserve Ratio) to ease the liquidity shortage, analysts said. "With election compulsions

behind, the pressure on the

RBI to throttle money supply growth will ease," said Crosby Securities in its March India Review.

"Cash flows from the formal to the "parallel" economy in the run-up to the elections will reverse its direction and seek profitable avenues in the bourses, it said.

But demand for money would continue to be high after the polls, keeping interest rates at the current levels of around 18-20 per cent, said Sunny Oberoi, India Managing Director of US Fund Manager Capital International Inc.

He expected the industry's unsatiated hunger for funds to continue until the first quarter of calendar 1997

Russian PM urges common market for CIS

MOSCOW, Apr 13: Russian Prime Minister Viktor Chernomyrdin on Friday urged the creation of a common market to boost trade among members of the Commonwealth of Independent States, reports AP.

Chernomyrdin, chairing a meeting of CIS prime ministers, said trade and economic relations," which make up the core of our cooperation, should be given top priority by the loose coalition of 12 former Soviet states, the Interfax news agency said.

The prime ministers ap-proved a draft plan for a economic interaction that Chernomyrdin said will open "a new page in progress toward a modern integrated community.

Valery Servo, Russia's minister to the CIS, said the plan "will be implemented in the next 18 months to boost cooperation among the member states in the social, economic, military and foreign political spheres," the ITAR-Tass news agency said.

Chernomyrdin urged CIS members to follow the example of Belarus, Kazakstan and Kyrgyzstan, which recently signed agreement with Russia on deeper economic ties.

Russian economist estimated that trade between Russia and other CIS countries will increase by more than six per cent this year and by another 15 per cent in 1997, ITAR-Tass said.

Chernomyrdin told a news conference that decisions had been reached on all 33 items on the agenda of the one-day meeting of prime ministers.

Among the approved items was a programme to combat organized crime until the year 2000, ITAR-Tass said.

made 80,000 dollars in stock gains last year. Their investments were placed in a blind trust shortly after they moved into the White House. The President has no say on how the family's investments are managed and does not know what holdings he has, said White House
