GCO demands DUCSU polls

The Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), a forum of some left-leaning student organisations, yesterday demanded dissolution of the DUCSU and immediate election to form a new one.

The last DUCSU election was held in 1990.

The GCO brought out a procession on the Dhaka University campus and held a rally at the Aparajeyo Bangla. The rally was addressed by Obaidur Rahman, Chunnu, Aslam Khan and Saifur Rahman Tapan.

The DUCSU had always contributed to the success of every democratic movement in the country, including the war of Independence in 1971. But the DUCSU is now in the grip of some terrorists, they alleged.

GCO leaders also urged the authorities to recover illegal arms from the campus for maintaining peaceful academic atmosphere.


