## Call to create mass awareness to check environment pollution

The six-day environment awareness programme for primary school teachers concluded in the city yesterday with a call to create mass awareness across the country particularly in the rural areas to check environment pollution, reports BSS.

Speaking on the National Environmental Management Action Plan (NEMAP), Executive Director of Bangladesh Centres for Advanced Studies Dr Saleemul Haq said NEMAP had been created through a nationwide consultative environmental planning process.

The people had identified health and sanitation issues as number one environment problem facing Bangladesh, he revealed.

Documentation Officer of Bangladesh Technical Education Board Masud Nabi Khan in his paper on Environmental Citizenship: The citizen's role in environmental protection" said that ordinary citizens can play an important role in deterring environmental degradation and primary school teachers can start this awareness through early training of children from class 1 to 5.

Presiding over the concluding

sessions founder President of North South University (NSU) Muslehuddin Ahmed said that the University had always a concern for community service and the NSU also interested in promoting environmental awareness at a grassroots level.

The NSU President outlined a plan to carry out programmes in various district towns among primary school teachers after which they would all meet together at a conference in Dhaka and in this way, he said a countrywide network could be formed.

Speaking as chief guest Canadian High Commissioner to Bangladesh Jon J Scott said that in Canada forest reserves and the marine environment are prime areas of concern and in Bangladesh important area of discussion was the environmental impact of fertilizer use.

Some 32 primary school teachers from 8 districts participated in the six-day programme jointly organised by the Institute of Development Environment and Strategic Studies (IDESS) of North South University and Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA).
