legal exhibitions with uncer-
sored obscene at different cin-
ema halls of the country, re-
ports BSS.

The suspended films are:
"The Last Hunter," "Camp-5
Women's Hell" and "The
Belt," of M/s M K Memo Film
Distributor, "Lady Punisher" of
M/s R K Trade International,
"Passion of Life" of M/s Maya
Enterprise, "Majestic Thun-
derbolt" of M/s Touch Film In-
ternational, "Double Cross" of
R K L Enterprise, "Hollywood
Vice Squad" of Heart Films In-
ternational, "Games of Desire"
of Shandi Traders, "Camp-5
Women's Hell" of Dhaka
Movies, "Crazy in Love" of M/s
Saga Enterprise and "Equals
Against Devils" of Alpina Khat-
achitra.

The film "The Last Hunter,"
"Camp-5 Women's Hell" and
"The Belt," "Majestic Thun-
derbolt" were exhibited at Chanda
Cinema Hall, "Double Cross"
and "Games of Desire" at Mal-
lika Cinema Hall, "Lady Pun-
isher" and "Passion of Life" at
Manoshi Cinema Hall in Dhaka.
The films "Crazy in Love" and
"Equals Against Devils" were
exhibited at the Star Cinema
Hall in Khulna.

The exhibitions of these
films will remain suspended in
the country until further order.

Army to co-host PASOLS-xxv

Bangladesh Army and the
US Pacific Command will co-
host the 25th Pacific Area
Senior Officers Logistic Semi-
nar (PASOLS-xxv) scheduled to
be held from September 21 to
26, reports BSS.

A Project Development
Committee (PDC) meeting be-
gan at a local hotel in the city
yesterday to finalise the

the PASOLS-xxv. More than
thirty officials from 20 coun-
tries are attending the four-day
meeting, an ISPR press release
said.

This is for the second time
that Bangladesh army is co-

PASOLS-xx was earlier held in
Dhaka in 1991.

in the world's poorest com-
munities.

USTC expels four students

tices, reports BSS.

people will be encouraged to
come to the polling centres in
large number to cast their
votes in the coming parliamen-
tary election, help the election
commission in implementing
the code of conduct and con-
tribute their mite to institu-
tionalise democracy through
the establishment of account-
able government.

For this purpose a work-
shop was held yesterday at the
central office of ADAB. 55
trainers from 32 NGOs took
part in the deliberations of the
workshop. A core trainers
team formed at the workshop
will impart necessary training
to five thousand workers in
this respect.

Directive to increase cargo handling

Sayed Manzur Elahi, Adviser
in charge of the Ministries of
Shipping, Communications,
Post and Telecommunications,
Civil Aviation and Tourism, and
Housing and Works, yesterday
directed the concerned au-
thorities to help increase
handling of imported and ex-
ported goods at the Benapole
land port, reports BSS.

He said, an advisory com-
mittee comprising the repre-
sentatives of port authority,
customs, clearing and forward-
ing agents and different ex-
porters and importers associa-
tions would be formed soon
with a view to gearing up the
port activities.

The adviser was presiding
over a meeting of port users
and concerned officials. The
meeting was informed that
construction of eight more
godowns is on progress while
the construction of a truck
terminal and hydrant system
for fire protection is under way
for the port facilities. The
adviser suggested installa-
tion of a fire station at
Benapole.
