The Bangladeshi participants will focus on contemporary art of Bangladesh as well as the rich cultural heritage during the exhibition and the seminar.

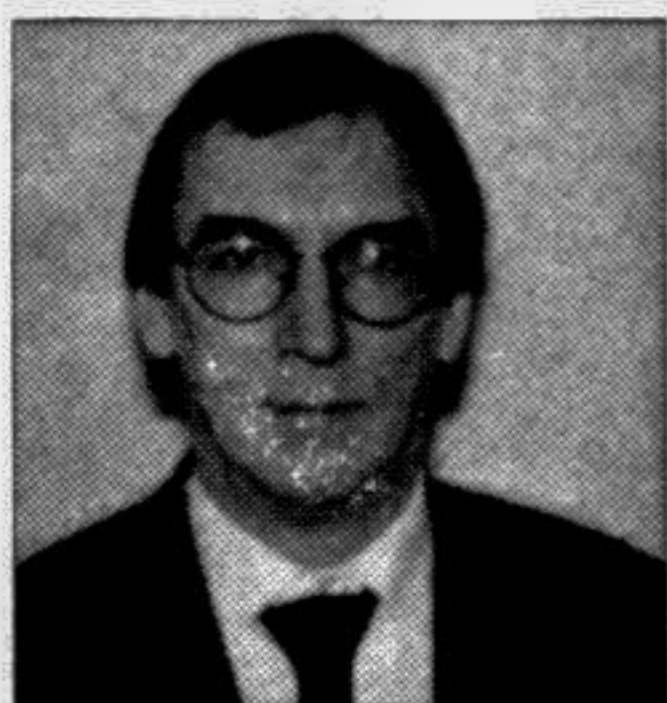
Fisons declares 30 pc dividend

At the meeting, shareholders elected a new five-member board of directors for the company with Michael Lienard as chairman and AKM Shamsuddin the managing director.

Lienard, a Belgian national, represents the UK-based parent company Fisons plc. He is the vice-president of Rhone-Poulenc Rorer in charge of Middle East and South Asia.

Rhone-Poulenc Rorer took over Fisons plc, globally in November last year.

Shamsuddin, the newly appointed managing director of Fisons (Bangladesh) is also the managing director of Rhone-Poulenc Rorer Bangladesh.

The Fisons meeting, chaired by the outgoing chairman GTM Healey, took note of various factors that affected the company's business last year. Despite problems, the company maintained positive growth in both sales and profits for 1995.

Shareholders also expressed satisfaction that business environment was improving following the installation of the caretaker government. They, however, were anxious about frequent power failures in the plant at Tongi resulting in production disruptions.

The annual general meeting was preceded by a meeting of the Board of Directors.

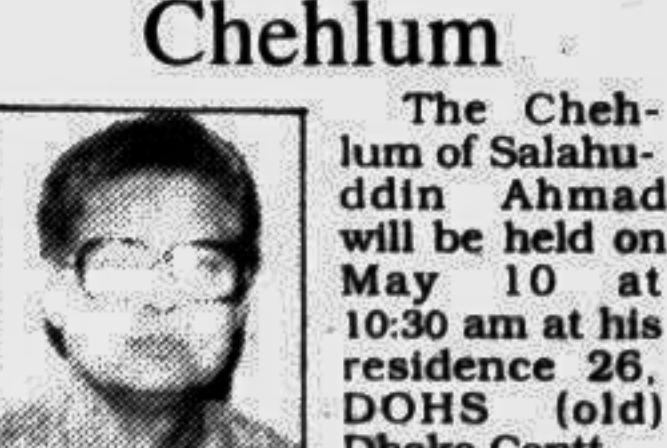

Dr Reza for creation of 'credit window' for unemployed engineers

Adviser for Energy and Mineral Resources and Water Resources Dr Jamilur Reza Chowdhury yesterday sought all-out help and cooperation of the professionals to hold the coming parliamentary polls free, fair and neutral, reports BSS.

He urged all concerned to strictly follow the election code of conduct for a free, fair and neutral general election.

Dr Reza made this call while addressing a discussion on 'Unemployed engineers: Problems and solutions' held in the auditorium of the Engineers' Institution here.

He said engineers should play active role in the political arena who are the forerunners of the advancement of technology.

Regarding the problems of the unemployed engineers, Dr Reza underlined the need for creating a separate 'credit window' in the form of commercial loan for them.

This efforts, on the one hand, will help hasten the country's industrialisation process which will generate more employment opportunities for the others and create a new dependable avenue of lending for the commercial banks, on the other, he opined.

The Adviser also suggested finding out more opportunities and avenues in manpower export for the unemployed engineers. He said we feel proud when we hear that our engineers have been working abroad with dignity and credibility.

Turning to the private investment in power sector, the Adviser said the government is formulating a framework to encourage private investment in the power sector to help the country to get rid of erratic power problems.

The discussion was arranged by the Engineers' Institution (IEB) on the occasion of Engineers' Day '96 which was presided over by Engr. Nazrul Islam, General Secretary of IEB, Dhaka centre.

Engr. Kamrul Islam Siddiq, Chief Engineer of Local Government Engineering Bureau (LGED) presented the keynote paper while the discussion was addressed by Engr. Ruhul Matin, acting president of the Engineers' Institution of Bangladesh. Engr. Fazole Elahi, General Manager of Titas Gas Company and Engr. Aminur Rahman.

The day-long Engineers' Day began with hoisting national flag and voluntary blood donation in the morning and concluded with staging drama 'Kholosh' at night. The drama was presented by Nagarik Natyangan.
