BHRC observed that main political parties are often resorting to provocative slogans and activities against each other which may create violence vitiating the peaceful atmosphere.


BHRC also demanded necessary steps be taken for of Conduct by the political parties for holding the election in a free, fair and impartial manner, said a press release.


