People's University to commence classes in Oct

People's University of Bangladesh, a private university project in the country, starts functioning from the coming academic year, October '96, says a press release.

It has completed preparations to enrol students in both Honours and Masters classes. The university will enrol students in English, Philosophy and Islamic History under the Faculty of Arts, Economics, Political Science, Sociology and Social Development under the Faculty of Social Sciences and BBA; MBA, Management and Accountancy under the Faculty of Business Administration.

The university will follow semester system. It is likely to introduce pharmacy and diploma courses in alternative medicine, homeopathy and physiotherapy.

The university will be located in the city.



Dr Amina Rahman passes away

Dr Amina Rahman, former adviser in late President Ziaur Rahman's Cabinet died of old age ailments in the city yesterday morning. She was 82, says a press release.

She had brilliant academic career and was the first Bengali woman to obtain a doctorate degree from the Yale University in 1950.

She resigned from the Dhaka University in the fifties and devoted her life in promoting child education in the country. She was also involved in social welfare activities. Her husband Shafiqur Rahman died in 1989. She is survived by two sons and a daughter.

Her elder son, Reaz Rahman, is now Bangladesh permanent representative to the UN and the younger one, Omar Rahman, teaches at the Harvard University. Her only daughter Zeenat Chowdhury is the wife of Faruq Chowdhury.

Her namaj-e-janaza and Quilkhwani will be held at 7 Circuit House Road, Shantinagar on Sunday June 16 after Asar prayers.

Friends, relatives and admirers have been requested to attend.

Upward trend in Ctg tea sale

CHITTAGONG, June 12: The weekly tea sale held here yesterday was marked an improved demand for all grades of teas but with declining prices, market sources said, reports BSS.

Pakistani buyers were more active but at reduced prices. Pakistan and Afghanistan competed for small broken and a handful of clean fannings. Sudan was also in the market.


Internal buyers including blenders lent a fairly good support as a result of which withdrawals were much less this week.

A bright feature of the sale was the continued good demand for bright liquorising teas which did not decline as much as others.


Bold and large brokenks declined further by Tk 2 to Tk 2.50 per kg. Medium brokenks were also a lower market declining up to Tk 2 smaller brokenks were irregularly easier, but the good liquorising types were about steady. Popular types sold between Tk 50 and Tk 54.50.

All fannings were an easier market selling at a drop of Tk 1.50 to Tk 2 per kg but well made good liquorising types were well supported at a drop of up to Tk 1 per kg popular types were also lower selling between Tk 50 and Tk 54.60. 1939 chests 805 gunny sacks and 20 bags of dust category on offer met with a fairly good demand. Well-made good liquorising red dust and peko dust were a good market and sold generally at firm rates. Dust and Churamoni 1 dust continued to meet with good competition and the better liquorising types were mostly dearer. All others were easier following quality.

Internal buyers along with the packeteers were active. There were 18,831 chests, 320 gunny sacks and 60 bags at teas on offer.


