Demonstration flight of Biman airbus

Biman Bangladesh Airlines organised a demonstration flight yesterday to familiarise journalists and the media men with Biman's newly acquired Airbus a310-300, reports BSS.

The flight departed from Zia International Airport at 0935 hrs and returned to Dhaka at 10:40 hrs. After cruising over much of southern Bangladesh and flying very low circling over Chittagong.

Biman's newly acquired Airbus has 221 seats including 25 in executive class and 196 in economy class. This is a widebody aircraft with twin-aisles in each cabin and offers very spacious seating in executive class and 2-4-2 seating in economy. Every seat in executive class has individual touch screen video with a choice of channels. There is an airshow system in each cabin that displays route map and the flight actually traversed. It has a particularly quiet cabin which is a distinguishing feature of this aircraft.

Biman has purchased this aircraft direct from the manufacturer, Airbus Industrie. It has a range of 4050 nautical miles and will be used on Biman's mid-haul routes particularly to the Gulf, Middle-East and Far East Asia.
