BRRI-IRRI-RLRRC review meet begins

A three-day long international review meeting of the BRRI-IRRI Rainfed Lowland Rice Research Consortium (RLRRC) was inaugurated here yesterday at a local hotel, reports BSS.

In all, twenty-five scientists from Thailand, Indonesia, India, the Philippines, Madagascar, Cambodia and Bangladesh are participating in the meeting.

Dr Z Karim, Director General of the Bangladesh Rice Research Institute (BRRI) attended the meeting as the chief guest. Dr SB Siddique, Director BRRI presided while consortium coordinator Dr RS Zeigler (IRRI) spoke on the objectives and progress.

In his inaugural speech, Dr Karim mentioned the problems and prospects of rice production of the South Asian countries in general and Bangladesh in particular. Dr Karim stressed the need for international collaborative research programme for attaining self-sufficiency of food grains and mentioned that in different seasons, rainfed rice alone contributes about 65 per cent of the total rice production of Bangladesh.

Salman greets CA, CEC

Salman F Rahman, convener of Prosperous Bangladesh Movement, yesterday congratulated the Caretaker Government, the Election Commission, political parties and the people for proper holding of June 12 parliamentary elections, reports BSS.

In a statement, Salman Rahman said the results of this election have appeared as the reflections of the people towards the established political parties. He said the participation of the people enthusiastically in the election has given democracy a firm root.

Sheikh Hasina felicitated

Late great leader Huseyn Shaheed Suhrawardy's son Rashid Suhrawardy yesterday congratulated Awami League president Sheikh Hasina and the party candidates and workers for achieving the considerable victory in the June 12 general elections, reports BSS.

In a statement here he expressed the hope that the transfer of power to the new government will be smooth and uncontroversial.

Rashid Suhrawardy said that he was delighted with the sentiments expressed by Sheikh Hasina that this is a time to heal the rifts and divisions that have scourged the country for far too long and that all parties will be consulted and their values and views will be given due consideration.

Referring to the results of the general election he said this is not just a great victory for the Awami League but, more importantly for the people of Bangladesh.

Khatib of Al-Azhar varsity in city

Polling was free, fair, says Liberty Int'l

The Liberty International, a Bangladesh-based international human rights organisation, in its initial reaction, expressed the view that actual conduct of elections on June 12 was with insignificant exception, generally free, orderly and fair, says a press release.

The president of Liberty International, advocate MA Muteleb said, "Our observer groups dispersed across several districts visiting polling sites in various urban and rural areas heard no significant complaint about casting or counting of ballots."

But there were allegations of some 'false voting' in many centres, he said.

According to Liberty International, many voters were not found in the voters list. For example, there was allegation that in at a centre in Sherpur district 3333 voters were registered in 1991 while the present voters list shows 3141 voters. In a village here 31 Hindu voters were left out of the list.

Many voters were not allowed to cast their votes due to mistakes/spelling mistakes of their names/father's names/husbands names in almost all polling centres, it said.

Termining the establishment of an election process by the government and the Election Commission as hopeful improvement, Advocate Muteleb stated, "The process created a better environment for fair elections."
