Moderate rainfall likely

Moderate rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely at most places across the country with moderately heavy to heavy falls at places over Chittagong, Barisal and Dhaka divisions in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Met Office says day temperature may fall by 1-2 degree Celsius throughout the country.

Meantime, Cox's Bazar experienced the highest 157 mm rain during the last 36 hours till 6 pm today.

Chittagong had 98 mm rain, Dhaka 54, Rajshahi and Comilla 33 each, Feni 26, Barisal 25, Faridpur 21, Sylhet and Mymensingh 17 each, Dinajpur 16, Rangpur and Majidpur 15 each, Sandwip 14, Teknaf 13, Khulna, Jessore, Kutubdia, Sakthira and Dinajpur 10 each, Bogra 9, Jessore and Rangpur 5 each in the period.

Country's highest temperature 36.0 degrees Celsius was recorded at Rangpur yesterday and the lowest 23.6 degrees at Rangmat.
