### 5 killed, 35 hurt in road accidents

SAVAR, June 24: Five people were killed and 35 others injured in two separate road accidents on Dhaka-Aricha highway on Saturday-Sunday. reports UNB

Police and witnesses said that two people died on the spot when a Dhaka bound truck carrying vegetable turned turtle after it lost control near Pakija here at 2 am

One of the dead was identified as Abdul Malek while the other, a 32-year helper, could not be identified.

In another mishap three people were killed and 35 others injured, ten of them seriously, when two buses collided head on near Turag river here at 4 pm Saturday.

One of the dead was identifled as Rashid, 37, and the rest could not be named yet.

The bodies were sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy. The injured were rushed to local hospitals. Two separate cases were filed with Savar police.

## Dacoity at textile mills in Savar: One killed

SAVAR, June 24: A labourer was killed and 10 others were injured when dacoits opened fire and stabbed them at a textile mills here early Sunday, reports UNB.

The dead was identified as Abbas Ali. 35, a labourer of Nurunnahar Textile Mills at Zirani in Savar.

Police said a gang of about 25 armed dacoits stormed the mill at about 1 am and looted valuables including cash money, yarn and cloth, worth about Tk 20 lakh.

The dacoits opened fire on the labourers and stabbed some of them when they tried to resist them. A case was filed with the po-

# AL, BNP gain while JP fails to retain seats in Moulvibazar

MOULVIBAZAR, June 24 Statistics of June-12 general election has reflected voters opinion which was assumed before the election by the political observers., People of Moulvibazar district clearly expressed their acclamation or rejection through ballots.

Two major parties - Awami League (AL) and Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) have strengthened their position in the district gaining more votes and seats in June-12 election compared to those in 1991 election. Jatiya Party (JP) once a strong party in the district which got two out of four seats in the 5th Parliament (1991) have failed to capture any seat this time.

Of the total four parliamentary seats in the district. AL won three seats while the only other seat has been won by the BNP.

In 1991 election (5th Parliament) BNP had failed to win any seat. Then AL and JP secured two seats each.

According to the statistics of June-12 election result in Moulvibazar district, all the AL nominees got 2,40,749 votes in 4 constituencies. Number of total votes for all AL candidates in 1991 election was 2.04,376.

BNP candidates got 1,56,171 votes from 4 seats this time but it was only 58,596 in 1991 election. JP nominees got 1.09,122 votes from 4 seats in June-12

election but their votes in 1991 election was 1,97,861. Votes in favour of AL and BNP has increased but votes for JP has surprisingly decreased this time.

Jamaat-e-Islami was always a weak party in Moulvibazar district and there was no new information in last election for the Jamaat candidates.

As many as six former MPs including whip of the opposition in the 5th Parliament of AL and central president of Bangladesh Muslim League (BML) who contested in June-12 elections from different constituencies of the district this time failed to win seats.

There were 34 candidates in the election race in 4 parliamentary seats of the district. Of them 22 contestants lost their security deposits. Even 10 candidates got below 500 votes and 19 candidates got below 5 thousand votes.

All the candidates of Jamaat (4). Jaker Party (3) Left Front (2). BML (2) and Gono Forum lost their deposit money. Vice-Principal Abdus Shaheed of AL got the highest

91.811 votes in Moulvibazar-4 while lowest 82 votes were cast in favour of central President of Bangladesh Muslim League (BML) Al-haj ANM Yousuf, in Moulvibazar-1.

According to election results. AL candidate from Moulvibazar-3, Azizur Rahman suffered serious defeat with 63,177 votes while another AL candidate from Moulvibazar-1, Md Shahab Uddin elected with only 33,179 votes.

The defeated AL candidate Azizur Rahman, secured 3rd place (in regards of number of votes) among all the 34 candidates. At least 4 candidates of JP and AL in different constituencies suffered defeat but secured more votes than that of elected AL candidate Shahab Uddin Ahmed from Moulvibazar-1.

However, in June-12 election, AL candidates Md Shahab Uddin Ahmed won from Moulvibazar-1 seat by securing 33,179 votes, Sultan Mohammed Monsur Ahmed won from Moulvibazar-2 seat by securing 52,582 votes, and Vice-Principal Abdus Shaheed won from Moulvibazar-4 seat by securing 91,811 votes.

The lone BNP candidate M. Saifur Rahman (Finance Minister of BNP govt) however, won from Moulvibazar-3 constituency winning a total of 84,292 votes

The gain of both the AL and BNP was not only evident from winning three and one seats respectively in the district, they also scored much higher number of votes than in 1991 election.

A comparative study of the number of votes secured by different parties in Moulvibazar district would give a clear picture of their respective posi-

In Moulvibazar-1 (Baralekha thana): AL won 27,588 votes (their candidate was Al-haj Imam Uddin Ahmed) in 1991 election, but this time AL candidate Md Shahab Uddin Ahmed was elected by securing 33,179 votes.

BNP, on the other hand, won 11,230 votes in 1991 (their candidate was Asad Uddin Batal), but this time their candidate Ebadur Rahman Chowdhury secured 20,089 votes but lost to his AL rival.

In 1991 election JP nominee Ebadur Rahman Chowdhury won a surprising victory from this seat by securing a total of 27,930 votes, but this time the new face of JP Brig (Retd) Masuk Ahmed Chowdhury secured 15,335 votes

The security deposits of all other candidates was forfeited in June-12 election. They were central President of Muslim League Al-haj ANM Yousuf (82 votes). Independent candidate Abdus Shaheed ( 162 votes). Md Abdul Malik of Jamaat (8.958 votes) and Hasan Uddin Chowdhury of Talamiz-e-

Islamia (5,994 votes). In Moulvibazar-2 (Kulaura thana): Awami League candidate Sultan Mohammed Monsur won 4552 votes in 1991 election but was defeated. This time the same candidate of AL secured 52582 votes and became victorious.

The BNP candidate Advocate Ataur Rahman (now late) secured 5,376 votes in 1991 election but Md Maksud Shaheen of BNP candidate this time won 31304 votes but lost and got 3rd place.

In 1991 election, JP nominee Nawab Ali Abbas Khan was elected by securing 61,108 votes but this time he lost to his AL rival by securing only 39992 votes.

As regards the other con-

testing candidates from this seat, security money of all were forfeited. These candidates are - Al-haj ANM Yousuf, Central President of Muslim League (379 votes) Khandaker Abdus Subhan of Jamaat (511 votes), Khondaker Lutfur Rahman of CPB/Left Front (1023 votes). BNP nominee former Finance Minister M Saifur Rahman bagged 35396 votes and defeated in 1991 election. This time the same candidate (lone BNP nominee who elected in the district) elected and bagged 84,292 votes. JP nominee MP in 1st Par-

All other candidates, who contested from this seat this year, lost their security deposits. They were — Abdul Goni Tarafder of Jamaat (2684 votes). Abdur Rashid Chowdhury of Gono Forum (266 votes) and Independent candidate Rama Kanta Singha (275

According to official statistics, a total of 5,65,500 voters out of 7,47,486 voters cast their votes in the June-12 general elections this year from Moulvibazar district. Of the total casting votes 6.097 votes was cancelled as these were not properly marked in the ballot papers. Of the cancelled votes 829 was cast in Moulvibazar-1, 1630 votes in Moulvibazar-2, 1535 votes were cast in Moulvibazar-3 and 2103 were cast in Moulvibazar-

## Drug addicts on rise in Kushtia

KUSHTIA. June 24: The number of addicted vouths is growing alarmingly here. Reports say, even rural youths are addicted to wine, opium. indigenous wine, morphine, sedative tablets. Mrita Sanjibani Sura, and other types of liquid containing alcohol.

According to a unofficial survey. Kushtia town and its suburbs have turned into open markets of in toxicated drugs. available in medicine and grocery shops. Phensidyl, one of the favourite drugs is smuggled from India into Kushtia in large quantities along with other kinds of drugs. These are also sent to other places of the country by various means of transport

The survey reveals that the number of addicted teenagers is only five per cent in the district but it is alarmingly growing day by day. Even minor boys are found looking for drugs in medicine shops. It is affeged that a well organised gang of criminals are engaged in smuggling these drugs into the Bangladesh territory from India. Although sale of drugs without prescription is strictly prohibited some dishonest medicine shop-owners are carrying on this business. It is also alleged that the drug addicted young men are often involved in various crimes for ex tortion of money, hijacking and fraudulent activities.

## Coconut cultivation faces setback in Madaripur

MADARIPUR, June 24: Coconut cultivation is facing setback in the southern region of the country due to attack of insects, lack of proper knowledge and absence of government initiatives, reports UNB.

## Soil fertility declining in Gaibandha

GAIBANDHA, June 24: Soil fertility have been decreasing gradually in seven thanas of the and oil-cake which is not fruitdistrict due to indiscriminate use of chemical fertilizer.

Most of the farmers lack knowledge on fertilizer ratios of soil. Very often they uses excess fertiliser specially urea TSP and NP with the hope of getting more production. But on using excessive fertilizer plants of crop developed rapidly before its maturity.

Besides, consecutive farming of same crops also largely affected the fertility of soil. The cultivable land of the district other than flood-hit areas are being used for the production of different crops twice or thrice in a year.

Only a limited number of

farmers uses natural manure like cow-dung, green fertilizer ful as like as chemical fertilizer for instant action. So, the farmers are now completely depends on chemical fertilzier. Besides, it needed additional labour for the manufacturing of natural manures. Moreover, it requires huge in quantity. So the practice of using natural fertilizer is declining. According to District Ag-

riculture Extension Department chemical fertilizer should be used after proper soil test but the practice is completely absent in the district. Local people fell that it is

inevitable to set up an institute for the proper testing of soil in the district.
