Thundershower likely

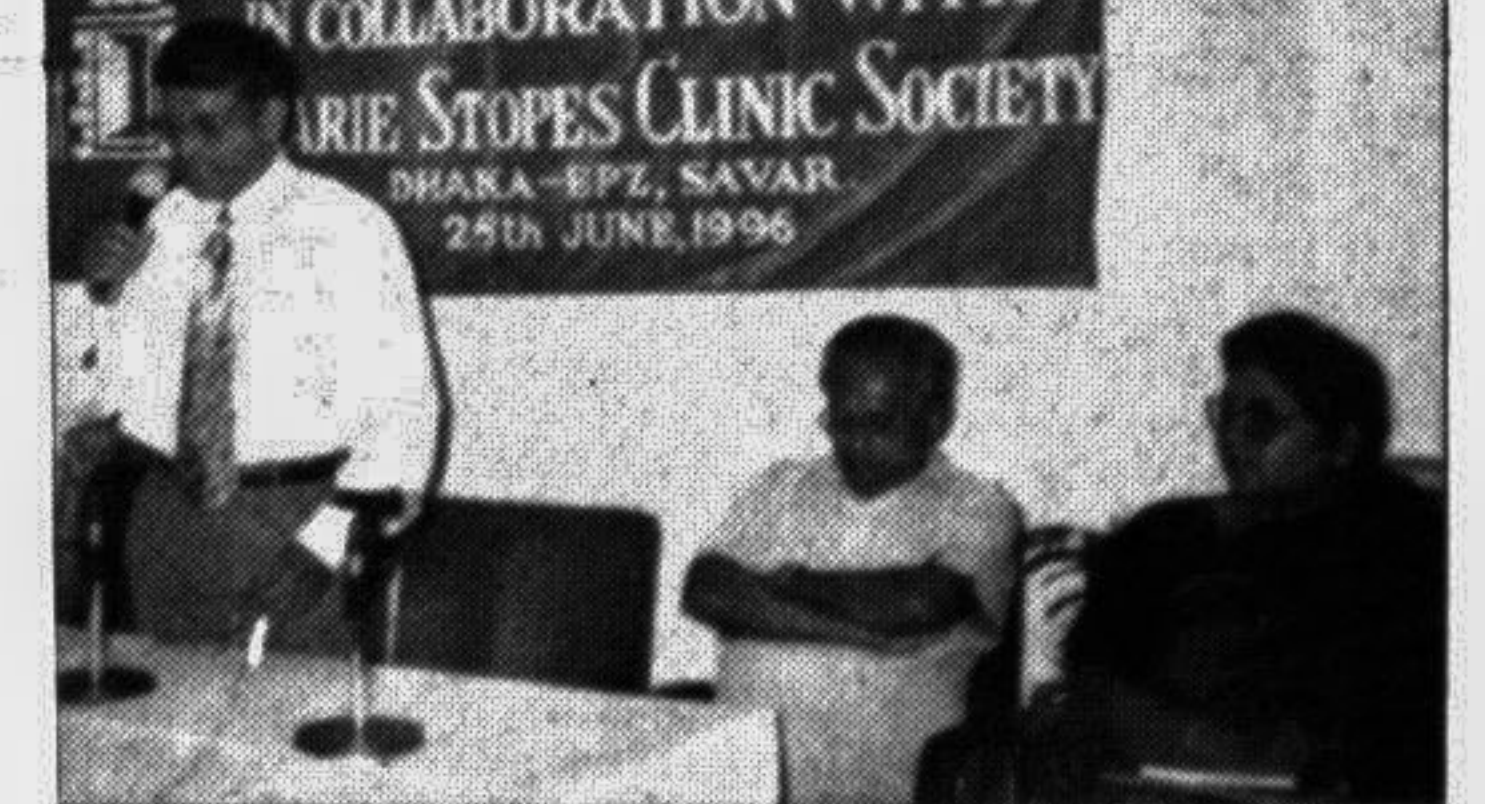
