Too Many Books Bad for Back

Sharhan, a student of class V, developed a backache. The consulting doctor told that the primary cause of the pain on the spine was the heavy school bag which Sharhan has to carry everyday to the fourth floor to reach his class. Filled with books and notebooks the school bag weighed almost six kilograms.

Like Sharhan, many other school children have to carry similar heavy bags to school. The vast syllabi and bulks of home works compel the children to carry great numbers of books to school

Over the past years there has been a rapid rise in the number of schools in Dhaka. Most of them are kindergartens and schools which offer "O" and "A" levels. There are some Bengali medium primary and high schools also. No doubt, the numbers of schools have increased but on the quality of the education they offer often hangs a question mark.

"There are plenty of schools in Dhanmondi. They are giving long lists of text books, vast syllabi, but most of them have very inexperienced teachers", says Mrs Chowdhury who has recently come to Dhaka and has been looking all over for a good school for her children.

Indeed, as soon as a child is admitted to a school, the parents find themselves perplexed over the long list of books, notebooks and other stationeries they have to buy. Beside the long list of books schools also follow vast syllabi for each academic year. Along with the main text books of Bangla, English and Maths. many schools set their syllabi with other addibooks, work books, hand writings, scraps. colouring books and music books. Among the school authorities there seem to

be a notion that the more books they can push under the children's nose, the greater the benefit for them.

In most of the schools the syllabus is very lengthy and the numbers of books are so many that it is not possible to complete the yearly syllabus at school. The children therefore are loaded with homeworks. Some schools have separate grades set for students' completion of their regular homework. Homeworks are regularly given and at such an amount that parents often hire private tutors for helping out the children.

Parents often express their displeasure and children grumble about the heavy weight of their school bags. But as long as the huge loads of home works continue and the vast school syllabi are there, the school bags will remain an unpleasant thing for the school children.

In Thailand students complained about two things: Too much home work and heavy bags. In a recent finding it has been seen that primary school students carrying bags weighing three kilograms or more ar : at risk of spinal damage that could affect their growth. The Thai Education Ministry had issued orders for primary school students not to carry bags which weigh more than two kilograms, high school students not more than three kilograms, and kindergartens not more than one kilogram.

In our country also, unless we take care of the heavy weight which our school children are burdened with, the children may become unwitting victims of physical harms in the process of acquiring education.
