Ruhul Amin Manik, 22, a worker of Ahmed Bawani Jute Mills at Demra, was under treatment at the Orthopedic Hospital, sources at the Hospital said.

A group of supporters of the Sramik League allegedly attacked Manik, president of the Sramik Dal of Demra thepa unit, with sharp weapons when he was going to Kacharighat from Norupur at about 5 pm.

AIDS prevention course for nurses begins in city

Some 7,500 people contract AIDS everyday in the world and more than 40 million will be infected by the killer disease by the year 2000, reports UNB.

The disclosure on the scourge of modern time came from a specialist at a training course on 'HIV/AIDS Prevention and Management for Nurses' that began at the Voluntary Health Services Society auditorium in the city Monday morning.

Country Programme Adviser of UNAIDS, Lisa Messersmith, who was chief guest at the opening session of the five-day training course, pointed out the vulnerability of Bangladesh to the deadly disease because of its spread in the neighbouring countries.

Mandela, Moi hail Hasina

President of South Africa Nelson R Mandela has congratulated Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on her assumption of the highest office of government of Bangladesh, reports BSS.

In a message of felicitations, the South African president also conveyed good wishes to the premier of Bangladesh and expressed the confidence that the already existing relations between the two countries would continue to expand under the leadership of Sheikh Hasina.

In another message, Kenyan President Daniel T Arap Moi greeted Sheikh Hasina on her becoming the Prime Minister of Bangladesh and said her overwhelming victory in the last elections was a clear indication of people's confidence in her leadership.

Daniel Arap Moi also expressed his confidence that the existing warm and cordial relations of friendship and co-operation between Kenya and Bangladesh would be further strengthened for the mutual benefit of the two countries.

Leader of the opposition in the Sir Lankan parliament representing United National Party, Ranil Wickremasinghe, in a letter of congratulations to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina expressed his firm belief that under her leadership Bangladesh and Sri Lanka would continue to maintain warm and fraternal ties enhancing the South Asian bondship.

Wickremasinghe, in his message, also said, "our association with the office of the prime minister of Bangladesh gives us the confidence that, we, in South Asia, are committed to the principles of democratic government."

President of Nepal Journalists Association (NJA), Manju Ratna Sakya, in a letter of felicitations, said the victory of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in the last elections had proved that the people of Bangladesh had undoubtedly vindicated their claim for people oriented democracy which would put an end for good to the dictatorial tyranny and demonic policy of murders and coups.

Members of Bangladesh Hardware and Machinery Merchants' Association of Dhaka, Chittagong, Rajshahi and Khulna circles and, Bogra and Barisal units of the association congratulated Sheikh Hasina on her assumption of the office of the Prime Minister.

Assuring the new government of all-out cooperation, they hoped that the government would play a dynamic role in finding solutions, to the problems prevailing in the economic, social, trade and commercial sectors.

Congratulating the Prime Minister, Chittagong Press Club president Muhammad Idris and general secretary Helaluddin Chowdhury hoped that the newly formed cabinet led by Sheikh Hasina would be able to give democracy an institutional shape.
