## 'India looking for investment opportunity in Bangladesh'

**CHITTAGONG July 11** The Indian High Commissioner to Bangladesh, Deb Mukherjee, said here today that India was closely looking for investment opportunity in Bangladesh, reports BSS.  
Exchanging views with the members of Chittagong Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI) at the CCCI conference room, Mukherjee said India was very much aware that the government of Bangladesh had been offering lucrative incentive packages to overseas investors.  
Referring to the existing bond of friendship between India and Bangladesh, Mukherjee said the prevailing trade imbalance between the two countries would be narrowed to a large extent in near future.  
He said Bangladesh is not only next door neighbour to India but also we belong to common geographical and cultural heritage. "Being the members of the SAARC, we should closely work for mutual benefits of the two countries," he said, adding that keeping this in mind, we should focus on the prospect of promoting two-way trade and the possibility of technology transfer. The Indian high commissioner said India would put in best efforts to remove all impediments for increasing the volume of trade between the two countries.  
Earlier CCCI president Sarwar Jamal Nizam, MP, welcoming the Indian high commissioner, said Bangladesh is considered as the third largest importer of Indian raw cotton, cotton yarn, and fabrics. "It indicates that large scale investment could be made with Indian textile know-how to jointly establish backward and forward linkage industries in spinning, weaving, dyeing and finishing in Bangladesh," he said.  
The chamber president requested the Indian high commissioner to come forward like Japan, Korea and other countries to set up such industries in the Chittagong export processing zone.  
Among others, CCCI senior vice-president Jafrul Islam Chowdhury, MP, Assistant High Commissioner Sushil Bharmra, chairman of Chittagong development authority Lt Col (rd) Mohammad Ziauddin Bir Uttom and past president Ali Ahmed also spoke on the occasion.
