In the hilly areas of the Chittagong Hill Tracts, where a ceasefire is in force until July 30, going missing is a common phenomenon for both the Bengali settlers and the Chakmas.

In very village, both Chakma and Bengali people come to tell how many had gone missing within the last few days. In the case of Kalpana's abduction, the local administration seemed to be experiencing quite an uneasy situation. The matter has been reported by national and international media as well as different local organisations. It is hoped that the local and national authorities will do every thing to find out and free Kalpana immediately.


