

Ganzoury, Kennedy greet Hasina

Prime Minister of Egypt Dr Kamal El Ganzoury has extended his heartiest congratulations to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on her appointment as prime minister of Bangladesh, reports BSS.

"I am confident that we will work together to strengthen our friendly relations," Ganzoury said in his message of felicitation.

Another report adds: Edward M Kennedy, senator of the United States, congratulated Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on her victory in last month's general elections.

In his message, Senator

Kennedy said, "I am writing to congratulate you on your victory in last month's general elections and to commend the free and fair elections as a significant achievement for the people of Bangladesh."

"I still have vivid memories of my visit to Bangladesh in 1972, just after the independence was achieved. I urged the members of Congress and the Nixon administration to recognise Bangladesh and deliver needed assistance and aid for the millions of refugees displaced during the struggle for independence," the message continued.


Both sides hoped that the existing Dhaka-Jakarta relations would further strengthen in the years to come.
