The meeting was attended by Home Minister Rafiqul Islam, State Minister for Foreign Affairs Abul Hasan Chowdhury and senior officials of the Special Affairs Division, Prime Minister's Office, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Ministry of Home Affairs.

**Policeman's widow receives Tk 1 lakh from PM's fund**

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday presented a cheque for Tk one lakh to Morjina Khatun, the widow of constable Abul Kashem Sheikh who was shot dead by highway bandits, reports UNB.

The money was given from the Prime Minister's special fund in recognition of the heroism and sense of responsibility of the late policeman.

Constable Kashem Sheikh was born at Brahman Baira village in Sadar thana of Sirajganj district on September 3 in 1957. He joined the police force in 1977 and performed his duties in Dinajpur, Rangamati, RRF, Rajshahi, Gaibandha and Bogra with utmost sincerity. He secured 15 prizes for praiseworthy activities during his service.

On July 8, Abul Kashem died when a gang of dacoits shot at him while he tried to resist them during highway patrol duty along with two other constables in Kahuu thana of Bogra district.

**Nasim informs JS Policy to streamline telecom sector soon**

The government is formulating a telecommunications policy to streamline the sector, Parliament was told yesterday, reports UNB.

The policy will be discussed in Parliament, said Post and Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nasim, replying to a supplementary question.

Nasim, responding to a starred question from Shah Haziuzzaman (Jessore-4), told the House that total number of telephone subscribers was 331,015 across the country, and of them, 154,986 were in the capital.

The total number of telephone exchanges in the country now stood at 696, the minister informed the House, in replying to a starred question of Jafrul Islam Chowdhury.

The Minister further told the House that the government had given contract to a private establishment, Seba Telecom, to install digital telephone exchange with NWD facilities in 194 thanas.

Replying to a supplementary question of KM Jahangir of Awami League, the Minister told Parliament that a total of 1,124 card phones were installed in the country till June this year. And of them, 537 card phones have ISD connections, he added.

Meanwhile, the cumulative overdue telephone bills of the Bangladesh Telegraph and Telephone Board to the subscribers stood at Tk 284 crore to date since the independence, Nasim said in reply to a question from Jafrul Abedin Faruk (Noakhali-1).

The authorities were taking various steps to realise the overdue bills, the minister added.

**Body recovered**

Police recovered the body of a young man who was reportedly murdered in Barura area under Gulshan thana in the city yesterday.

The body of Hazrat Ali, son of late Hafizuddin of Barura area, was found in a road-side marshland near Salunpara bridge in Gulshan thana area around 9 am yesterday.

Police sent the body to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) morgue. Marks of cut were found on his body, police and DMCH sources said.

The motive behind the killing could not be known immediately.

Ali, bus-helper, had been missing since Saturday last when some people called him out his residence, said DMCH sources quoting Ali's family members.

A case was filed with Gulshan thana in this connection. None, however, was arrested till last night, police said.

**Community approach to medical edn stressed**

Minister for Health Salahuddin Yusuf yesterday emphasised improvement of community-based medical education.

He said this while inaugurating a national workshop on 'Assessment Method in Medical Education' organised by the Further Improvement of Medical Colleges Project in the city. He also reiterated the pre-polls pledges of the Awami League government to bring about changes in the country's medical education.

Yusuf said that the present curriculum was "didactic and curative with very little emphasis on preventive and promotive medicine."

"Thus there is an urgent need for an improved curriculum with more emphasis on preventive medicine. This will take care of primary health care," he added.

He said that under the recently introduced Further Improvement of Medical Colleges Project, which is a component of the Fourth Health and Population Project, students were now going to the villages to know about the community health problems.

"This will help bring in an attitudinal change in our future doctors to serve in the rural health centres," he noted.

He said that the government would help set up an institute training for the medical college teachers and nursing and paramedical institutes.

The workshop, attended by medical college teachers was addressed by Health Secretary Muhammad Ali, Director General of Health Services Prof AK Shamsuddin Siddique, WHO representative Prof Myo Thwe, Director Medical Education, DGHS, Prof AKM Nurul Anwar president.

The workshop put forward recommendations to the Ministry regarding updating of the present examination system for doctors.

The Minister urged the participants to devise process of constant monitoring and supervision of medical education in colleges which would help the government develop a system for its quality control.

The Health Secretary said that the quality of medical education, had deteriorated over the years.

But it was time to soup up health sector, he said.
