

THE DIVISION BELL AND THE **FLOYDS**

S you look around this room — tonight ▲ Settle in your seat and dim the light. Do you want my blood, do you want my tears?

What do you want from

- and with these words Pink Floyd gracefully launched into their latest album "The Division Bell".

It actually took the veteran musicians of Pink Floyd seven long years to collect the ingredients for the album. And I, who am an avid Floyd-fan, upon listening to it, at once knew it had been worth the wait. Pink Floyd's last album was.

"A momentary lapse of reason." released in 1987. But they also released two live albums -'Delicate Sound of Thunder' (1988) and 'Secrets' (1991), in between. Most songs in the "Division Bell" album has been written and composed by band-leader David Gilmour. And for this reason, a basic difference has been noticed in the lyrics and also the music. The lyrics are now much more earthbound and realistic. It deals with various social inconsistencies, and other intimate topics. The band has placed their songs in a more human context, Check this out — "For millions of years.

just like animals. Then something happened

unleashed our power of imagination We learned to talk." (keep

talking) The times have changed since. "The pipers at the Gates of Dawn", the first ever Floyd album, and with it have changed the songs, rhythms, lyrics and music, yielding gradually to the compelling pressure of time. And the mu-

wonderful. From the initial gentle plucking acoustic passages of, "Poles Apart" to the ghostly blues of 'marooned'. and all the other emotional bending, innovative pitchshifting effects, vibrates. , swift fretboard tappings and echoing effects, all bear the master touch of Gilmour. The solo or guitar melody at the end of, "A great day for free dom" and it's delayed distortion effects is undoubtedly great stuff for any guitar-buff like me, to devour voraciously. Actually, as the absence of Roger Waters becomes clear through lack of catchy basslines in the songs, it is made up for, by the astoundingly fantastic guitar riffs all over the whole album.

"Lost for words" and "Coming back to life" is un doubtedly the two best songs in this album. In the former, the intro consists of simply a rhythmic plucking on successions of the scales — c and major. The main theme of the song is how we remain engulfed in the cares of life and how our world becomes shrouded in veils of darkness. "Coming back to life" is probably one of Pink Floyd's best ever compositions as much because of it's catchy rhythm as it's marvellous lyrics. The words deal with the resurrection of a broken man — a man coming back to life. The guitar solo and intro, which are both devoid of much use of effects. are almost like symphonies themselves. Lastly, in the wake of the

band's somewhat faccid recording. 'A momentary lapse of reason' it seemed doubtful that the band would exist. But 'The Division Bell' has defi nitely defied the odds and captured the hearts of mil lions. This surprisingly subtle and well-arranged piece of work demonstrates how, for

sic, naturally, has been considerably scaled down to more earthly tunes, by David Gilmour - who seems to be resolute to siphon of cartoonish excesses from the songs, which fuelled albums like "Animals" "The Wall". Pink Floyd which initially made its debut as a psychedelic rock band, have, in keeping with the album's more earthbound concerns. reduced the cosmic sound effects, laughs and psychedelicized audio effects to a bare minimum.

Roger Water's departure definitely left an adverse effect on the band. But now, apparently. Gilmour's emotionally charged guitar work is providing all the sonic commentary. that is needed. The Floyd axeman is seemingly hitting his stride with his rich legates. phrasing. And unlike many other rock heroes, whose days of glory are long gone, his playing gets better and better as this talented musician retains his master status. Check out the introductory melody in. what do you want from me. The descending chromatic scales he uses, is absolutely

the Floydians, with time, have come much wisdom. Let's hope this was not the division bell for Pink Floyd, for they have shown through this al bum, that they still haven't reached the dark side of the moon yet.

This fabulous album, in my opinion, has been grossly un derrated. And according to present sales records, it has become the third highest selling album by Pink Floyd right after "Dark Side of the Moon" and "The Wall". The tape could actually even by considered as a wonderful col lection of marvellous guitar riffs and suitable, fluent lyrics l absolutely can not comprehend why it was so under rated. May be it was merely the absence of Roger Waters or perhaps the lack of weird cosmic effects and sonic psychedelazation, that failed to fuel the album. But I, myself would without any hesitation recommend this album to any one. It is truly something. worth collecting.
