Although the all share price index at the Dhaka Stock Exchange last week (DSE) marked a slight rise over the previous week's record, the over all situation at the market was not positive always.

The index rose by 13.16 points, from 1095.99 points to 1109.15 points, at the closing of last week and the market capitalisation marked an increase by Tk 167.74 crore compared to the previous weeks record.

The All Share Price Index at Chittagong Stock Exchange (CSE), however, fell 8.01 points to 459.51 points last week from the previous weeks' 451.50 points.

The market capitalisation of the CSE also declined by Tk 18 crore to Tk 4116 crore from the previous weeks' Tk 4134 crore.

Although the week (last week) had started with a bullish trend at the two share markets in the country, they became bearish in the middle of the week.

The all share price index at DSE registered a new record.



4 trawlers sink: 20 fishermen feared drowned

BARISAL July 26: Twenty fishermen are feared drowned as four fishing trawlers sank in the Bay of Bengal yesterday afternoon, some 40-km south of Kuakata in Patuakhali district.

Sources in Kuakata, when contacted, said this morning that the fishing trawlers - FB Sultan, FB Salam, FB Khalil and FB Maer Doan -said from Kuakata with 45 fishermen on board. The trawlers reached deep sea in the afternoon and sank in the Bay shortly afterwards due to strong current and high waves. Of the 45 fishermen, 25 were rescued within two hours by some fishing trawlers and were admitted to Mahipur Health Complex. The rest 20 remained missing till the filing of this

It is early now to form definite ideas of the proposed improvements until the details of the project preparation studies, expected to be completed in three phases by 1997 are known Among the specific areas likely to figure in such studies for action are reported to be civil works equipment for traffic management, institutional streng-

thening and policy studies. The most important factor while we consider these issues is that the project need be processed for implementation with a sense of urgency. In this context, it may be wrong to assume that Dhaka's rickshaws which operate economically on almost 95 per cent of the road system can be eliminated totally in future because many roads and areas are not accessible to buses or mun buses. Moreover, there is the question of rehabilitation of the large number of people dependent on this occupa tion. What seems possible to achieve at present is to keep the main transport corridors

free from rickshaws and other slow-moving vehicles. Though the present disarray in our transport system is somewhat different in nature because of the overwhelming of presence of rickshaws. other Asian cities like Bangkok, Manila, Hong Kong are also facing tremendous congestion problems which they are trying to grapple in their individual ways. There seems to be no scope now for dithering in our case because of the approaching 21st century with the attendant increased demands for expanded communication and transport facilities.
