Laws contrary to equal rights to go: PM

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said her government would repeal all laws contravening equal rights and privileges of the people irrespective of their cast and creed, reports UNB.

Responding to the urge from a 21-member delegation of Janmashtami Uddapan Parishad of Chittagong and Dhaka, who met her at the Tejgaon office, the Prime Minister said Bangladesh is an abode of peace and communal harmony.

"All people belonging to various religions should have

the right to perform their respective religious rites and activities without any hindrance," said Hasina, adding that the Awami League government is committed to non-communal politics.

The delegation, led by Binod Bihari Chowdhury, Chief Patron of the organisation, facilitated Sheikh Hasina on her assumption of the office of Prime Minister.

They also called upon the Prime Minister to repeal all laws and acts contrary to fundamental human rights.

With the formation of Awami League government under her leadership the country and the nation would get rid of communal venom which was out to destroy the very entity of the nation with the killing of father of the nation, Chowdhury hoped.

Apprising the PM of various problems and activities of the organisation, Chowdhury said, as a non-political religious body, the Parishad was carrying out various social and humanitarian activities.

He invited the Prime Minister to attend as chief guest a grand Janmashtami convention to be held on September 3 in Chittagong.

Tk 900 cr earned annually thru' leather exports

Minister for Water Resources Abdur Razzak yesterday said Bangladesh earns some Tk 900 crore every year through exporting leather and leather products, reports UNB.

He was addressing as chief guest a freshers reception of students of Bangladesh College of Leather Technology at its auditorium in the city yesterday.

Organised by the college students union, the function was presided over by Principal of the college, AN Wahid Uddin.

The minister said the country's leather industry was playing a very important role in building our national economy.

"Our overall development could not be achieved without the development of technical and vocational education," he said.

Govt urged to raise taxation on tobacco

Adhunik, a voluntary national organisation for the prevention of smoking, yesterday urged the government to increase taxation on tobacco by 200 to 400 per cent, reports BSS.

In a press statement by the president of Adhunik, National Professor Nurul Islam said this taxation, which cannot be

challenged by anyone who is committed to the health and welfare of the people, will protect people from the fatal effects of tobacco.

He said the present government is committed to the welfare of the people.

Islam said tobacco taxation is something unique in the sense that it has been found to be a very effective weapon against prevention of smoking, as people give up the habit of smoking if the taxation raises the price of tobacco beyond their means.

First Class First

Mehezebunnessa Rahman Tumpa stood First Class First in the BSc Agri Economics (honours) final examinations of 1993, held in May this year, from the Bangladesh Agriculture University (BAU), says a press release.

She is the only daughter of former vice chancellor, BAU, and editor, Dainik Janata, Dr Muhammad Asadur Rahman, MP and Merina Rahman.

1-hr token strike observed at Mirpur exchange

Casual workers and employees of Bangladesh Telegraph and Telephone Board (BTB) observed a one-hour token strike in Mirpur exchange demanding regularisation of their jobs, reports UNB.

Telecommunication Casual Workers-Employees Welfare Association, who enforced the work abstention, also pressed for voting right in the CBA election.

It also held a meeting at Mirpur exchange premises, which was addressed by association leaders Ataur Rahman, Abdul Wadud, Afzal Hossain, Hasina Akhter and Tahmina.

Later, they submitted a memorandum to the Labour Directorate and the General Manager, BTB.

The casual staff, many of them working for 10 to 15 years, are getting Tk 60 per day for 26 days a month, according to the association. There are about 5,000 casual workers under BTB throughout the country.
